Activities undertaken by Students/Residents in Program	Serve 160 hours or four weeks rotation in a community health centers that exposes them to multidisciplinary teamwork, under the direction of a preceptor in their health area. Help them identify mentor. Receive information on NHSC, Community Health Center (330), administer a pre and post test in cultural competence, and Multidisciplinary health care team and managed care. Students and Residents will also be exposed to Health Information Technology.
Coordination	Develop a SEARCH implementation plan including travel, logistics, communication and clinical rotation. Student/Residents will choose community health sites. A manual / community clinical experience guide will be given to student/residents as part of the orientation prior
