- A strategically vital power support platform, the Arsenal is home to First Army, the Army Sustainment Command, the Joint Munitions Command, Army Contracting Command and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers
- In May 2009 JMTC was designated by the Secretary of the Army as a Center of Industrial and Technical Excellence. This designation recognizes JMTC's proven expertise in the manufacture of Mobile Maintenance Systems
- Joint service provider for the Army, Marine Corps, Navy, Air Force and Coast Guard
- Supports more than 54,000 Active, Reserve component, retired Military, Civilian employees and Family members in a 150 mile radius
- State-of-the-art information technology infrastructure to support the Department of Defense worldwide mission
- A self-sustaining installation, the Arsenal's hydroelectric plant generates one-third of the Island's electrical power and it has its own water production facility
- Rock Island National Cemetery is one of 117 national cemeteries operated by the Veteran's Administration's National Cemetery Administration in the United States. It covers 70 acres and has over 25,000 grave markers




