AMSAS-OPS-T MEMORANDUM FOR Deploying Soldiers ISO ASC

SUBJECT: Army Sustainment Command (ASC) Pre-Deployment Training

- 1. Welcome to the Army Sustainment Command Pre-Deployment Training. All deploying Soldiers will report to Rock Island. Classes will be held at Rock Island Arsenal (RIA) as well as at the appointed hotel where all deployees will reside.
- 2. You will be assigned to the Army Sustainment Command during this phase of your predeployment training. The training will be provided by the US Army Sustainment Command at Rock Island, IL. You will need to provide a copy of your military BIO, along with your ORB/ERB, 2A and OER/NCOER to G1 Mobilization Coordinator for ASC. She can be reached by phone at 309-782-5699. This information will be used by the in-theater Commanders/OPD's to determine the positions you will be assigned to while deployed.
- 3. You will deploy to Southwest Asia (SWA) to support one of our Army Field Support Brigades or LOGCAP. This training prepares you for the logistical and technical support you will execute during your deployment. To assist you with your pre-mobilization preparations, attached are Fort Benning's CONUS Replacement Center (CRC) Pre-Certification Training requirements with instructions and websites. We recommend that you complete as much of this training as possible prior to your mobilization date. To assist you with your pre-mobilization training and to find answers to basic questions concerning your deployment processing, review Fort Benning's CONUS Replacement Center (CRC) website at https://www.benning.army.mil/infantry/197th/crc/.
- 4. We have set aside limited time for Pre-Certification training while at RIA. You will also need to complete Information Assurance Training at https://ia.signal.army.mil and bring the training completion certificate with you.
- 5. Training at RIA will include an APFT and mandatory STX Lanes familiarization training exercise. Ensure that you bring a copy of any temporary or permanent profiles, if applicable. Scan and send a copy of your PHA to the ASC Command Surgeon, ATTN: COL Robert T. Pero, robert.pero@us.army.mil, to expedite the medical screening process prior to your arrival at RIA. See the ASC Medical Readiness Pre-Deployment Requirements for further guidance.
- 6. It is imperative that the ASC G3 staff identify Soldiers who may have "DWELL Time" remaining prior to receiving their orders for this mobilization tour. If you have deployed within the last 12 months to OCONUS locations and did not complete 12 months at home station, please provide your name and contact information to the G3 Training SGM at 309-782-8674. Please note that even if you signed a waiver to accept this tour, the ASC Commander will review all Soldier's request to deploy, who fall in this category, to ensure that the Department of the Army's intent is being met.
- 7. Lodging arrangements are being coordinated and all deploying Soldiers will be notified of location once coordination is complete. ASC will provide the hotel information and phone number once the accommodations have been confirmed. You will be required to reserve your hotel room at that point. Ask for a room in the block of rooms reserved for

- <u>ASC Pre-Deployment</u> when making your reservation. Transportation is being arranged for you during your stay. Once you have your flight itineraries, provide that information to the G3 Training Development Specialist at 309-782-2224.
- 8. A Yellow Ribbon training event will be held for Soldiers' family members. Contact us to indicate how many family members will be attending the Yellow Ribbon Training. Family members expenses are funded by the Yellow Ribbon Program. Soldiers are authorized to invite <u>no more</u> than two dependents to attend this training. Contact the G3 Training Development Specialist at 309-782-2224 with questions or concerns. Child Care Services will be provided for any children in attendance under the age of eleven. Please ensure that a current copy of their immunization record and Child and Youth Services (CYS) questionnaire is provided.
