SUBJECT: State Plan For the State Vocational Rehabilitation Services Program
under Title I, Part B and State Plan Supplement for the State Supported
Employment Services Program under Title VI, Part C of the Rehabilitation
Act of 1973, as Amended - Fiscal Years 1998-2000

POLICY STATEMENT: This transmits the preprint and instructions for
the completion and submittal of the State plan for the State Vocational
Rehabilitation Services Program under title I, part B of the
Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, (Act) and the State plan
supplement for the State Supported Employment Services Program under
title VI, part C of the Act for fiscal years 1998-2000.

For a State to receive Federal funds under title I of the Act for its
vocational rehabilitation program and under title VI, part C for its
supported employment program, it must have its State plan and
supplement approved by the Rehabilitation Services Administration (RSA)
by September 30, 1997.

If the State plan and its supplement are subject to the State review process,
RSA approval of the plan and its supplement is contingent on the receipt
of comments from the review process, or the passage of at least 60 days
from the date of submittal of the plan to the State review process.

The title I State plan and its title VI, part C supplement are to be submitted
to RSA by July 1, 1997.
