SUBJECT : FY 1992 MAINTENANCE OF EFFORT LEVEL IN THE  
TITLE I VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION (VR) SERVICES  
PROGRAM

CONTENT : Attached is a table showing each State's Maintenance of Effort (MOE) level for  
Fiscal Year 1992. The non-Federal share of expenditures for the prior three  
fiscal years (1989, 1990, and 1991) was used to calculate the Fiscal Year 1992  
MOE level. The non-Federal share of expenditures was taken from the year-end  
or final Financial Status Reports (SF-269) on file in RSA.

The MOE level for any particular fiscal year is the average of the three prior  
years' non-Federal expenditures. These figures, for the appropriate years, will  
continue to be used in future MOE calculations, unless RSA receives a revised  
SF-269 report, the changes are adequately explained, and RSA has approved the  
revised report.
