- SUBJECT : Revised FY 1993 Allotment Table and Grant Award for the Supported Employment Program (Title VI, Part C)

This Information Memorandum provides each grantee a corrected 1993 Allotment Table and award adjustment to reflect an updated annual allotment amount in the Supported Employment Program. This Information Memorandum supersedes the information and grant award transmitted through Information Memorandum IM 93-02, dated November 5, 1992.

This correction was necessary to incorporate Section 632(a)(1)(B) of the 1992 Amendments to the Rehabilitation Act which states "...if the sums appropriated to carry out this part for the fiscal year exceed by \$1,000,000 or more the sums appropriated to carry out this part in fiscal year 1992, no State shall receive less than \$300,000, or one-third of one percent of the sums appropriated for the fiscal year for which the allotment is made, whichever is greater." The legislation further stipulates in Section 632(a)(2) that Guam, American Samoa, the United States Virgin Islands, the Republic of Palau and the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands "...shall be allotted not less than one-eighth of one percent of the amounts appropriated..."

1/ Under Development

The allotment table generated in November had used the \$250,000 minimum for each grant award. However, the allotment should reflect \$300,000 as the minimum for each State and an increased Territorial minimum. The Department apologizes for any inconvenience this may have caused.
