SUBJECT : FINANCIAL STATUS REPORT (SF-269) FOR FY 1992

CONTENT : During Fiscal Year 1992, State Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) agencies were awarded \$1,783,530,000 in Federal funds under Section 110 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, to provide rehabilitation services to persons with disabilities. An analysis of the year-end SF-269's indicates that 82 State VR agencies obligated \$1,777,080,971. These reported expenditures are subject to change until the final SF-269 is submitted.

Out of the 82 State Agencies reporting, 14 showed unobligated balances of \$6,449,029. However, due to the Supplemental Appropriations, Transfers and Rescissions Act of 1992, Florida requested and was granted a waiver to match/obligate its hurricane disaster related funds through November 15, 1993. Also, Northern Mariana Islands has the right to carryover its unobligated funds to the next year.

Attached are two State agency tables showing: (1) unobligated balances and (2) State expenditures.

State VR agencies spent \$521,642,943 in State funds. The total amount of Federal and State funds expended for Fiscal Year 1992 was \$2,298,723,914.
