SUBJECT: FY 1996 Independent Living, Part B, Supported
Employment, Client Assistance, and Protection and
Advocacy of Individuals Rights Grant Awards Under
the Continuing Resolution, P.L. 104-31

CONTENT: The Department is currently operating under a
Continuing Resolution (P.L.104-31) through November
13, 1995. During this period, funds are made
available based on the funding levels approved under
the Continuing Resolution.

Under RSA formula grant programs, except Basic
Support, Vocational Rehabilitation grantees will
receive 12 percent of the total annual amount
established under the Continuing Resolution. The
annual funding amount established under the
Continuing Resolution reflects the lower of the
House or the FY 1995 appropriated amount, reduced by
5 percent.

Please find attached your FY 1996 grant award and an
allotment table as issued under the Continuing
Resolution for your RSA formula grant program.
