SUBJECT: FY 1996 Independent Living, Part B, Supported Employment, Client  
Assistance, and Protection and Advocacy of Individual Rights Grant Awards  
Under the Second Continuing Resolution, P.L. 104-56

CONTENT: The Department is currently operating under a second Continuing Resolution  
(P.L.104-56) through December 15, 1995. During this period, funds are made  
available based on the funding levels approved under this Continuing  
Resolution less the mandatory funds provided for minorities under Section 21 of  
the Rehabilitation Act and those funds set aside for technical assistance as  
provided under Section 509 of the Act.

Under RSA formula grant programs, except Basic Support, Vocational  
Rehabilitation grantees will receive 9 percent of the total annual amount  
established under the second Continuing Resolution less the mandatory set  
asides indicated above.

The annual funding amounts under this Continuing Resolution, is the FY 1995  
appropriation level. For your reference, an annual allotment table is attached.

When comparing the attached FY 1995 appropriated amounts to the FY 1996  
appropriated amounts under this Continuing Resolution, please note that there  
were population updates; therefore, in most cases, the amounts do differ.

Please find attached your FY 1996 grant award as issued under this Continuing Resolution for your RSA formula grant program.
