SUBJECT : FY 1996 Independent Living, Part B, Supported
Employment, Client Assistance, and Protection and
Advocacy of Individual Rights Grant Awards Under the
Continuing Resolution, P.L. 104-99

CONTENT : The Department is currently operating under a
Continuing Resolution through March 15, 1996.
During this period, funds are made available based
on the funding levels approved under this Continuing
Resolution, less the mandatory funds provided for
minorities under Section 21 of the Rehabilitation
Act and those funds set aside for technical
assistance as provided under Section 509 of the
Rehabilitation Act.

Under RSA formula grant programs, Vocational
Rehabilitation grantees will receive 14 percent of
the total annual amount established under this
Continuing Resolution, less the mandatory set asides
indicated above.

The annual funding amounts under this Continuing
Resolution, except for the Basic Support Program, is
the FY 1995 appropriation level.

Please find attached your FY 1996 grant award as
issued under this Continuing Resolution for your RSA
formula grant program.
