FY 1996 Allotment and the Annual Allotment Table for the Independent Living, Part B, Supported Employment, Client Assistance, and Protection and Advocacy of Individual Rights Programs

CONTENT:

Attached is an initial final grant award, an adjusted final grant award and an Annual Allotment Table for the appropriate formula grant program for Independent Living, Part B, Supported Employment, Client Assistance, and Protection and Advocacy of Individual Rights Programs based on the 1996 Appropriation Act. These funds are allotted from October 1, 1995 through September 30, 1996.

Please note that due to the numerous Continuing Resolutions, grant awards were issued this fiscal year at various annual levels of funding. The cummulative awarded amount of the initial final grant award was adjusted to agree with the State's annual allotted amount listed in the Annual Allotment Table (attached). Therefore, the cummulative grant amount of the original grant award and the adjusted grant award differs.

The FY 1996 appropriation levels for the RSA formula programs, except the Basic Support Program, less the mandatory set asides provided for minorities under Section 21 of the Rehabilitation Act and for technical assistance as provided under Section 509 of the Rehabilitation Act are as follows:
