SUBJECT: FY 1996 Allotment and the Annual Allotment Table for the Basic Support

Program

CONTENT: Attached is the initial final grant award, an adjusted final grant award and an

Annual Allotment Table for the Basic Support Program based on the 1996

Appropriation Act.

The FY 1996 appropriation level for the Basic Support Program, minus the American Indians (Section 130) program set-aside, is \$2,103,762,000.

Under the Basic Support Program, an initial allotment of \$1,683,009,600 (80 percent of the annual allotment) is issued to States for the period of October 1, 1995 to June 30, 1996. The remaining balance of \$420,752,400 (20 percent of the annual allotment) will be awarded during the fourth quarter of the Federal fiscal year.

Please note that due to the numerous Continuing Resolutions, grant awards were issued this fiscal year at various predicted annual levels of funding. The cummulative awarded amount of the initial final grant award was adjusted to equal 80 percent of the State's annual allotted amount listed in the Annual Allotment Table (attached). Therefore, the cummulative grant amount of the original grant award and the adjusted grant award differs. The minimum payment to a State (other than Guam, American Samoa, the Virgin Islands, the Northern Mariana Islands, and the Republic of Palau) for FY 1996 under the Basic Support Program is \$7,012,540.
