CONTENT: Attached is a copy of the RSA FY 1995 Annual Report which is based on the

"Report of Vending Facility Program" (Form RSA-15) for the reporting period October 1, 1994 through September 30, 1995, submitted by State licensing

agencies pursuant to the Randolph-Sheppard Act.

The Randolph-Sheppard Vending Facility Program has continued to provide persons who are blind with remunerative employment at increasing levels of earnings. A total of 3,510 blind vendors operated 3,414 vending facilities located on Federal and other property. The program generated \$408.9 million in gross income and \$80.2 million in net earnings to vendors for average annual earnings of \$26,420 per vendor.

This Annual Report, prepared by the Vending Facility Branch, Division for Blind and Visually Impaired, contains statistical and financial analysis of the Randolph-Sheppard Program.
