- SUBJECT: FY 2000 Grants Awarded Under the First Continuing Resolution
- CONTENT The Department is currently operating under a Continuing Resolution (CR) through October 21, 1999. During this period, funds were made available for the Vocational Rehabilitation State Grant, Client Assistance, and Protection and advocacy for Individual Rights Programs, based on the FY 1999 funding levels.

Vocational Rehabilitation agencies will receive a total of \$140,000,000 of the annual funding amount established under this CR. A total of \$2,731,997 was awarded in the Client Assistance Program and \$2,674,488 was awarded in the Protection and Advocacy of Individual Rights Program.

The latest per capita income (PCI) and population data were used in computing the funds for FY 2000 under the CR. For per capita income, RSA uses the average per capita income for years, 1996, 1997, and 1998. This information is available from the U.S. Department of Commerce, Bureau of Economic Analysis. Population data were updated as of July 1, 1998, as available from the U.S. Bureau of the Census.
