SUBJECT: FY 2000 Annual Grant Award and Annual Allotment Table for the
Independent Living Services for Older Individuals Who Are Blind
Program (Title VII, Chapter 2 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as
Amended)

CONTENT: The FY 2000 Independent Living Services for Older Individuals Who Are
Blind Program annual grant award and the annual allotment table, based
on the 2000 Appropriation Act, are attached.

In accordance with Section 752 of the Act, the FY 2000 appropriation for
the program, less the mandatory set aside provided for outreach to
minorities under Chapter 2 of the Rehabilitation Act, is \$14,850,000. The
minimum allotment for States is \$225,000 and \$40,000 for Territories.
These funds are allotted from October 1, 1999 through September 30,
2000.
