In accordance with Section 752 of the Act, the FY 2000 appropriation for the program, less the mandatory set aside provided for outreach to minorities under Chapter 2 of the Rehabilitation Act, is \$14,850,000. The minimum allotment for States is \$225,000 and \$40,000 for Territories. These funds are allotted from October 1, 1999 through September 30, 2000.
