CONTENT: Attached is your grant award for the reallotment in the Basic Support Program, if you requested and/or released funds during the reallotment period. No grant award is attached if your annual allocation did not change during this reallotment.

Funds were distributed in the following priority order: (1) Raise all States to CPIU (3.4 percent) level - \$10,406,875 distributed; (2) Early implementation Ticket-to-Work states - \$2,389,385 distributed; and (3) General Reallotment Formula - \$12,472,795 distributed.

For your information, no funds were released for reallotment in any other formula grant program administered by RSA.
