CONTENT : Attached are your grant awards for reallotment in the Basic
Support Program and Supported Employment Program, if you
requested or released funds during the reallotment period. No
grant award is attached if your annual allocation did not change
during this reallotment.

For the Basic Support Program, funds made available during this
reallotment period, through a Maintenance of Effort (MOE)
penalty or relinquished funds are as follows:

Funds were distributed in the following priority order: (1) raise all States, where possible, to the CPIU (1.8514 percent) level - \$13,554,798 (to 21 States); and (2) distribute remaining funds by the General Reallotment Formula - \$22,276,135.

For the Supported Employment Program, a total of \$47,100 was relinquished by CNMI. Funds were distributed to 29 State agencies using the population-driven allocation formula

For your information, no funds were released for reallotment in any other formula grant program administered by RSA.
