SUBJECT : Reallotment in the Basic Support Program — FY 2006

CONTENT : Attached is your grant award for reallotment in the Basic Support Program, if you requested or released funds during the reallotment period.

For the Basic Support Program, funds made available during this reallotment period through a Maintenance of Effort (MOE) penalty or relinquished funds are as follows:

Funds were distributed in the following priority order: (1) all states requesting funds were raised to the CPIU level for FY 2006 - \$8,964,607 (to 17 states); and (2) remaining funds were distributed using the general reallotment formula. Funds were not distributed to agencies that did not request additional funds.

No funds were released for reallocation in the Independent Living Part B, Independent Living for Older Blind, Client Assistance and Protection and Advocacy Programs.
