- SUBJECT: Verification, Reinstatement and/or Retirement of RSA Program Policy Directives
- BACKGROUND: On September 23, 1990, the Rehabilitation Services Administration (RSA) announced a new System for Issuing Policy and Information (SIPI). This system replaces the previous RSA Policy System that was established in 1983. The SIPI provides a new mechanism to convey required actions or conditions to State agencies and other grantees -- the Policy Directive (PD). The PD replaces the former Program Policy Directive (PPD), many of which have expired.

POLICY

STATEMENT: The purposes of this issuance are (a) to clarify which PPD's are still in effect; (b) to reinstate many PPD's which have expired; and (c) to retire several PPD's which have already expired or were superseded by other issuances.

The PPD's shown on Attachment A are still in effect and will continue in effect until rescinded or superseded by a subsequent issuance.

The PPD's listed on Attachment B have technically expired. This issuance reinstates these PPD's. The PPD's on this attachment will continue in effect until rescinded or superseded by a subsequent issuance.

	Attachment C lists PPD's which are retired by this issuance. Many of these PPD's have already expired. Please note that ten PPD's were retired by RSA-PPD-89-03. Please refer to that issuance for the specific numbers of those PPD's.
