AMBER: ROAD SURFACE IS WET, SLUSHY; SNOW < 4 INCHES;
VISIBILITY BETWEEN 20-50 METERS; TEMPERATURES BETWEEN 30F-35F
DEGREES

RED: ONLY MISSION-ESSENTIAL AND EMERGENCY VEHICLES ARE
AUTHORIZED; ROAD SURFACE IS FLOODED, SNOW IS DRIFTING &
BETWEEN 4-8 INCHES DEEP; VISIBILITY BETWEEN 15-20 METERS;
TEMPERATURE BETWEEN 10F-30F DEGREES

BLACK: ONLY EMERGENCY-ESSENTIAL VEHICLES ARE AUTHORIZED;
ROAD SURFACE IS HEAVILY FLOODED; HEAVY DRIFTING SNOW, 8+ INCHES

What Delay or Closure Means



- A decision that impacts the community and its non emergency front door services
- Personnel reporting instructions apply to the Garrison non emergency essential workforce
- Schools may open during a delayed status
- AAFES and Commissary will attempted to open as scheduled
- Call ahead before travelling



Nuisance Alarms



- Experienced just over 19K in one month period
- Every Nuisance Alarm requires an action from the IOC and/or Military Police
- Top 3 causes of a Nuisance Alarm
 - Failure to disarm after entering
 - Entry without having armed/disarmed pass code
 - Opening of Emergency Doors
- Knowingly causing a Nuisance Alarm with military dispatch is the same as intentionally pulling a fire alarm

- ID Card

- Application
- US title or registration

One of the following:

Shipping document DD Form 788 (**Motorcycles MUST be listed**)

Or

Customs Form (AE Form 550-175A) if shipped privately

Or

Current NATO Registration

- Fee
- Waiver if required
- Power of Attorney (**POA**) required if person registering vehicle is not listed on current registration

NOTE: Name on title/registration and insurance card must be same as person registering POV (**POA**)

NOTE: Any customer registering their 1st POV in USAREUR Vehicle Registration system **MUST** provide a copy of their orders or memorandum from human resources verifying logistical support

- **What is it**

- **A safety awareness program designed to increase community member's knowledge and awareness of German traffic laws & Driver and Vehicle requirements and Installation Traffic Codes for U.S. Forces in Germany**

- **Reminders**

- **All passengers in a vehicle must wear seatbelts. Drivers receive citations for passenger violations**
- **Children under 12 years of age are not permitted to ride in the front seat of a vehicle unless rear seats are occupied by younger children**
- **Cell phone usage is prohibited unless a hands free device is utilized**

Motorcycles:

 - 6th Grade and up – Yes
 - Outside
 - Birth to 4 Years – NEVER
 - K to 3rd Grade – Must be in sight or hearing distance from supervising adult
 - 4th & 5th Grade – Must have ready access to supervising adult at all times
 - 6th & 7th Grade – Up to 6 hours

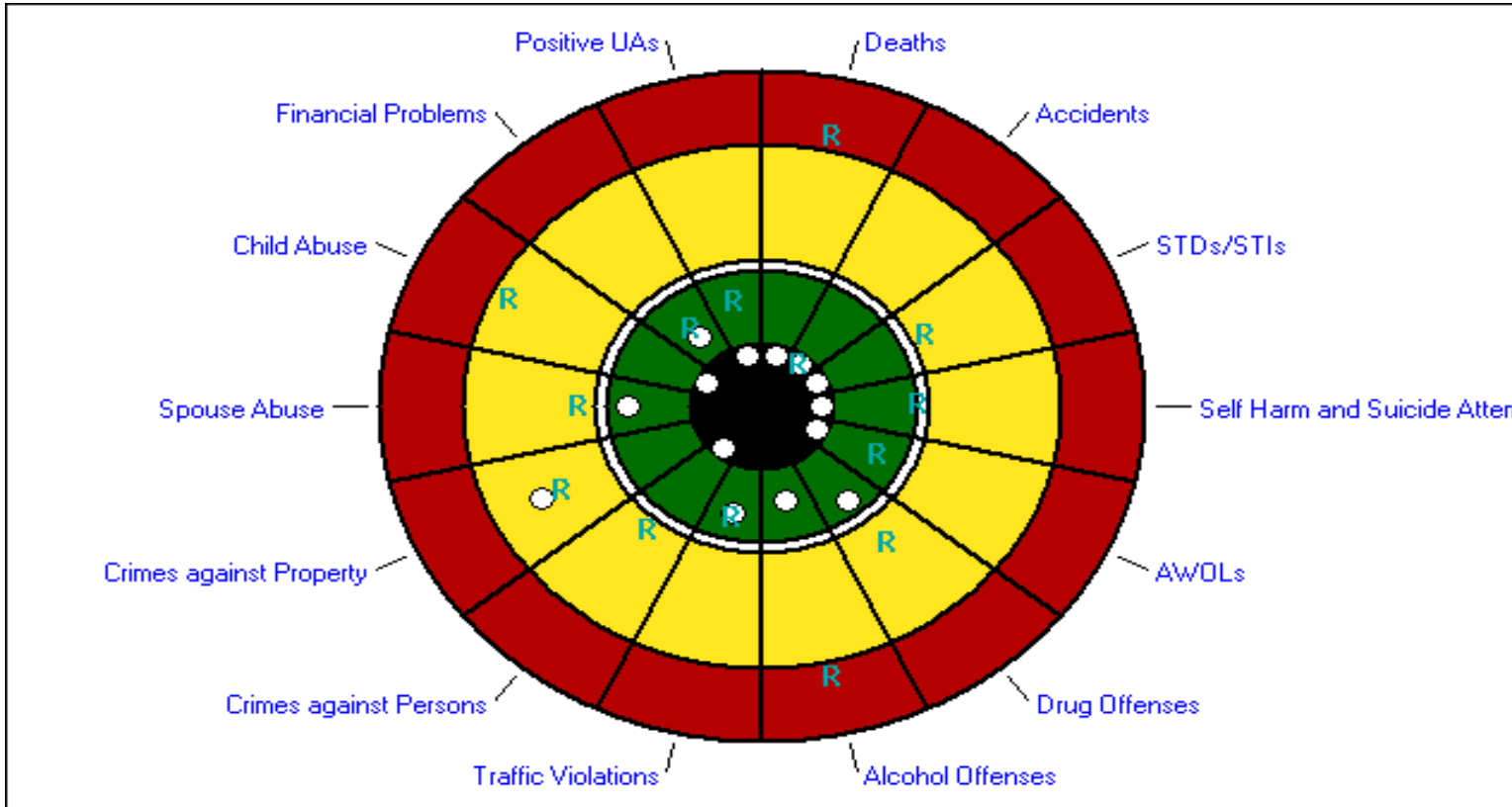

Winter Traffic Safety



- **Winter Tires**

- Requirement based on actual weather conditions, not on calendar date
- M+S rated tires must be on the vehicle during snow, ice, slush –
DRIVER'S RESPONSIBILITY
- Minimum tread 1.6 mm, recommended 4 mm
- Request/verify that rental cars have winter tires
- On-the-spot fine 40 Euros, traffic obstruction/accident 80 Euros *plus* risk of denial of insurance coverage (gross negligence)

- **“Be Safe – Be Seen”**

- Pedestrians and bicyclists are difficult to recognize during the dark time of the year – typically within 25 and 40 meters
- Retroreflective material (warning vest/collar, PT belt, decals,...) increases visibility up to 140 meters

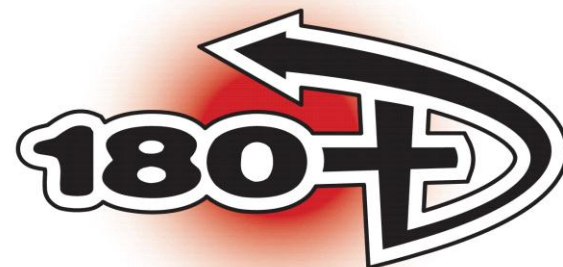

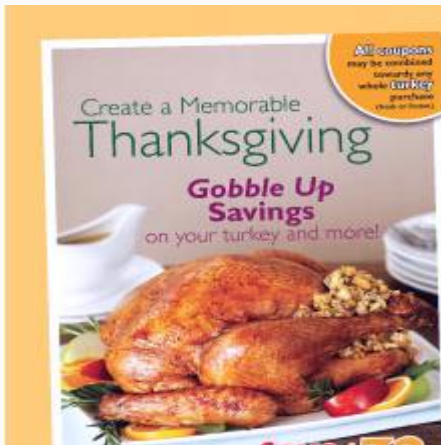
