



ACCELERATION REQUEST OSAN AMERICAN HIGH SCHOOL

PARENTAL REQUEST: Students who meet their teacher's minimum course requirements for passing a semester class and who are leaving within 20 calendar school days prior to the end of a semester may be given advance additional assignments to cover the work in each subject.
