## We are Committed to a mutually beneficial relationship between Native Hawaiians and the U.S. Army, Hawai'i by:


- Enhancing education and understanding of Native Hawaiian issues, culture, values to Army agency staff

- Leveraging opportunities for proactive dialogue between the Army and Native Hawaiians


## We are Committed to:


