Fourth Grade and Above

Scout groups may visit the bison and the Interpretative Trail without advance notice. They may also visit the Lederman Science Center during regular business hours, 8:30 AM–4:30 PM, Monday through Friday; and 9:00 AM–3:00 PM on Saturdays. Group leaders must contact Maureen Hix at 630-840-5588 or edreg@fnal.gov to schedule a visit to the Center. Fermilab will not provide docents, but any group larger than ten individuals must be added to the Center's calendar. One adult chaperone for every five children is required.
