Herbst** who came on board in September, was the State Department Coordinator for Reconstruction and Stabilization and former Ambassador to the Ukraine; **Mr. Jean D. Reed**, former Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense for Chemical and Biological Defense and Chemical Demilitarization; and **Lt. Gen. (ret) James N. Soligan**, former Deputy Chief of Staff for Transformation, Allied Command Transformation.

Mr. David Becker will be a senior fellow at the <u>Center for Complex Operations</u> focused on U.S. Government civil agency activities during stabilization and reconstruction, and humanitarian assistance operations. Ambassador Herbst is the new Director for the <u>Center for Complex Operations</u> (CCO). Mr. Leon Fuerth will be joining the <u>Center for Technology and National Strategic Policy</u> (CTNSP) to focus his work on forward engagement and security policy. Mr. Gompert will be joining the <u>Center for Strategic Research</u> (CSR) to study the US-China strategic relationship, with special attention to the nuclear, space, maritime, and cyber domains. Mr. Reed will be joining CTNSP to explore topics relating to chemical biology defense and national security. Lt. Gen. James Soligan has been named the Director for the new <u>Center for Transatlantic Security Studies</u> at INSS

Dr. Hans Binnendijk, Director of INSS, and Vice President for the Office of Research and Applied Learning, has reorganized NDU's research programs to strengthen research focused on supporting the Office of the Secretary of Defense, the Joint Chiefs of Staff, Combatant Commanders, and other U.S. Government Agencies. These new additions to the INSS team will strengthen the capability to meet that mission.
