THE CCLEB WILL CONVENE ON 10 SEPTEMBER 2012 AND WILL SELECT OFFICERS FOR:
  - A. RESIDENT CAREER LEVEL SCHOOL (CLS)
  - B. OLMSTED SCHOLAR PROGRAM NOMINATION BOARD
  - C. CONGRESSIONAL FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM
  - D. INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS OFFICER PROGRAM (IAOP)
