GENTEXT/REMARKS/1. THE PURPOSE OF THIS MARADMIN IS TO ANNOUNCE THE COMMANDANT'S PROFESSIONAL INTERMEDIATE-LEVEL EDUCATION BOARD (CPIB). THE CPIB IS A COMPREHENSIVE APPROACH IN A NON-STATUTORY COMPETITIVE BOARD PROCESS TO SELECT THE BEST AND MOST FULLY QUALIFIED OFFICERS FOR INTERMEDIATE-LEVEL PROFESSIONAL MILITARY EDUCATION (PME), GRADUATE-LEVEL EDUCATION, AND SELECT SPECIAL DUTY ASSIGNMENTS. THE CPIB WILL CONVENE ON OR ABOUT 1 OCTOBER 2012 AND WILL SELECT OFFICERS FOR:

- A. INTERMEDIATE LEVEL SCHOOL (ILS) TO INCLUDE FELLOWSHIPS AND FOREIGN PROFESSIONAL MILITARY EDUCATION
 - B. CONGRESSIONAL FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM
 - C. INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS OFFICER PROGRAM (IAOP)
