1. PURPOSE. TO ANNOUNCE THE RESULTS OF THE COMMANDANT'S CAREER-LEVEL EDUCATION BOARD (CCLEB) THAT CONVENED ON 10 SEPT 12 TO SELECT THE BEST AND FULLY QUALIFIED ELIGIBLE OFFICERS FOR CAREER-LEVEL PROFESSIONAL MILITARY EDUCATION (PME), GRADUATE-LEVEL EDUCATION, AND SELECT SPECIAL DUTY ASSIGNMENTS DURING FY 2013. OFFICERS SELECTED BY THE CCLEB WILL BE ASSIGNED TO THE FOLLOWING PROGRAMS/SCHOOLS: CAREER-LEVEL SCHOOLS (CLS) TO INCLUDE FELLOWSHIPS AND FOREIGN PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION; OLMSTED SCHOLAR PROGRAM; CONGRESSIONAL FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM (CFP); INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS OFFICER PROGRAMS (IAOP); SPECIAL EDUCATION PROGRAM (SEP) LAW AND ADVANCED DEGREE PROGRAM (ADP) LAW; SPECIAL EDUCATION PROGRAM (SEP) AND ADVANCED DEGREE PROGRAM (ADP); JUNIOR OFFICER STRATEGIC INTELLIGENCE PROGRAM (JOSIP) AND JUNIOR OFFICER CRYPTOLOGIC CAREER PROGRAM (JOCCP).

2. ALL OFFICERS SELECTED AS PRIMARIES, DEFERRALS FROM FY12, MCRC SCHOLARSHIPS AND ALTERNATES (SEE PARAGRAPHS 3 THROUGH 6, BELOW) WILL BE SLATED DURING THE DEC 12 SLATING PANEL BASED ON THE NEEDS OF THE MARINE CORPS AS WELL AS OFFICER'S QUALIFICATIONS AND PREFERENCES. SELECTED OFFICERS MUST COMPLETE THE ADMINISTRATIVE REQUIREMENTS NOTED IN PARAGRAPH 7 AND INDICATED NEXT TO THEIR NAME NO LATER THAN 26 OCT 12. COMMANDERS SHALL ENSURE OFFICERS COMPLY WITH THESE REQUIREMENTS.
