World Bank PSLO

- Illinois Global Partnership became the World Bank's first "Private Sector Liaison Office" (PSLO) in the U.S. with the goal of increasing the number of U.S. firms participating in World Bank-funded projects.
- 100 Private Sector Liaison Offices in 79 countries
- The PSLO's facilitate companies' access to WBG business opportunities, services and knowledge, and act as the voice of their national private sector in advising the WBG on how to better engage companies on development issues.
- In addition to the WBG, the PSLOs also work closely with other multilateral development institutions, including the Inter-American Development Bank, Asian Development Bank and African Development Bank.

Millennium Development Goals

- Agreed to by 189 nations in 2000 at the United Nations Millennium Summit

 - ⇒ Promote gender equality and empower women
 - ⇒ Reduce child mortality
 - ⇒ Improve maternal health
 - ⇒ Combat HIV/AIDS, malaria, and other diseases
 - ⇒ Ensure environmental sustainability
 - ⇒ Develop a global partnership for development





- Investment projects
- Economic reform packages
- Technical assistance




IDA/IBRD Business Opportunities: Export of goods and services

- 2 types of procurement: directly to the WBG or under a under WBG funded project
- \$25 billion in contracts = 40,000 procurement contracts/y
 - 90% below \$1 million and 60% below \$0.5 million
 - 83% goods, equipment, civil works and 17% consulting



IBRD/IDA Lending by Region FY 2008




IBRD/IDA Lending by Sector FY 2008




IBRD/IDA Lending in Energy & Mining Active Projects








- Political risk insurance currency transfer restrictions, expropriation, war/civil disturbance, breach of contract
