SUBJECT: Fort Lee Crosswalk Safety Policy

1. REFERENCES:

- a. Army Regulation 385-10, The Army Safety Program, 4 October 2011.
- b. Virginia Law Code 46.2-928.

2. PURPOSE: To establish the Fort Lee Crosswalk Safety Policy.

3. APPLICABILITY: This policy applies to all military and civilian personnel on Fort Lee to include family members and contractors.

4. POLICY:

a. Pedestrians on Fort Lee have the right of way in crosswalks and are required to use crosswalks at all times if available. Pedestrians must pay attention at crosswalks and obey the "Walk" and "Don't Walk" warnings when there are pedestrian control signals.

b. Motor vehicles must yield to pedestrians in a crosswalk. Pedestrians who are crossing the road at a point other than a marked crosswalk must yield the right of way to all vehicles.

c. This policy will be strictly enforced throughout the installation.
