MEMORANDUM FOR PILOT TRAINING CANDIDATES

SUBJECT: APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. The 163rd Fighter Squadron will be conducting interviews in the late summer of 2012 to select potential officers to attend pilot training for fiscal year 2013. Exact interview date is to be determined.
- 2. Applicants must possess a four-year college degree, and must not be over the age of 30 by the time they start pilot training. Applicants may be in college but must possess at least a bachelor's degree six months prior to a potential UPT class date. Also, they must be able to pass a Military Flying Class I Physical. Applications are due no later than 30 June 2012. Application packages must include the following:
 - Resume (Include date of birth)
 - Cover Letter
 - Copies of college transcript(s)
 - Three letters of recommendation from people you have worked for directly or know you well
 - Air Force Officer Qualification Test (AFOQT) results
 - Flying time and ratings currently held

- 4. Candidates selected for an interview will be notified via e-mail. Be sure to provide us with your current address, email and phone or cell number. Please update information if it should change.
