Acting Director Acquisition

Mr Herway was appointed as the Acting Director Acquisition for the NATO Communications and Information (NCI) Agency as of 1 January 2013. Previously, he was the Chief of Contracts for the NCI Agency.

In his past assignments he was selected as the Principal Contracting Officer first for General Electric and Pratt and Whitney aircraft engines, and then for the V-22 Osprey tilt-rotor aircraft with Bell Helicopter and Boeing. His last assignment at NAVAIR was as the Chief of the Rotary Winged Aircraft and Aircraft Engines Branch, in the Combat Aircraft Contracts Division.

He transferred to the Naval Air Systems Command in Arlington, Virginia, where he spent the next ten years. One of his first assignments at NAVAIR was the competitive acquisition of an Undergraduate Jet Flight Training System, which included the aircraft, aircraft simulators, classroom curriculum, and an automated flight scheduling system. He was later assigned as the lead negotiator on the S-3 Weapons Systems Improvement Program with Lockheed Martin. This program converted the carrier-based S-3A Anti-Submarine Warfare aircraft to the S-3B version.

Mr Herway began his career as a Contracting Management Intern at the General Services Administration where he had two rotational assignments in the Public Building Service and the Federal Supply Service located in Washington, D.C.

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
