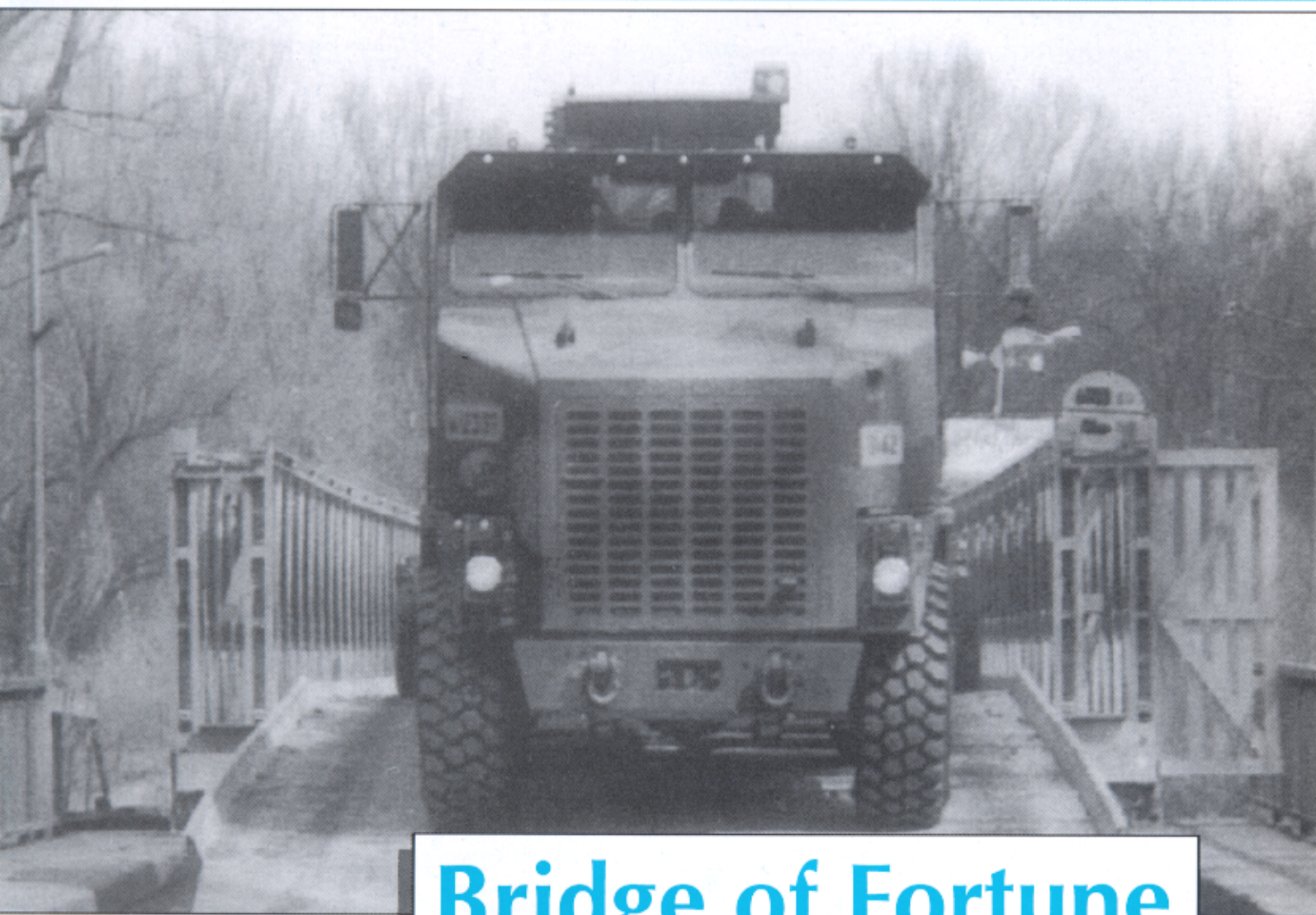

COVER


The bridge over the Sava River between Gunja, Croatia, and Brcko, Bosnia, became known as the "bridge of death" when it was bombed and over 80 refugees died. An assault float bridge served as a replacement, but deploying U.S. forces needed something stronger to carry vehicles like the heavy transporter system shown on the cover.
