

Glen Canyon Dam Guided Tours



Glen Canyon Natural History Association, a non-profit educational organization, in cooperation with the Bureau of Reclamation, provides guided tours through Glen Canyon Dam.

Tours are approximately 45 minutes long and are provided for the public free of charge through the end of calendar year 2008. Beginning January 5, 2009, there will be a fee for guided tours of Glen Canyon Dam (Please see the fee schedule below). Each tour is limited to 20 persons (includes infants and children). Before the scheduled tour, each person or party must register at the reservation desk located inside the Carl Hayden Visitor Center. If you have a party that consists of 10 or more persons, please see group reservations.

Group Reservations

Group tours are available for large parties including schools, travel clubs, universities, and other organizations. Group tours are limited to 40 persons per tour and are conducted at 9:15 a.m., 10:15 a.m., 1:15 p.m., and 2:15 p.m. Mountain Standard Time daily.

School Groups	\$0.50/person
