### I. Background

### A. Overview

This report is based upon an audit of the Denton for Congress Committee and the Saginaw County GOP Congressional Boosters Club ("the Committees") undertaken by the Audit Division of the Federal Election Commission in accordance with the Commission's audit policy to determine whether there has been compliance with the provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). The audit was conducted pursuant to Section 438(a)(8) of Title 2, United States Code, which directs the Commission to make from time to time audits and field investigations with respect to reports and statements filed under the provisions of the Act.

The Denton for Congress Committee registered with the Federal Election Commission on April 2, 1976, as the principal campaign committee designated by Edward Brady Denton, Jr., the Republican candidate for Michigan's Eighth (8th) Congressional District. Mr. Denton authorized the Saginaw County GOP Congressional Boosters Club on September 14, 1976, to accept contributions and make expenditures on his behalf.

The audit covered the period April 1, 1976, through September 30, 1977, the final coverage date of the latest reports filed by the Committees at the time of the audit. The Committees reported the following activity for the period ending December 31, 1976.  $\underline{1}$ /
