This attached advertisement is seeking nominations of highly skilled and qualified leaders to perform as Incident Commander (IC) of a Great Basin Type 2 Incident Management Team for 2013-2016. If assigned, the individual will be expected to serve not only in the Great Basin, but also on a National level in the assigned position. All applications must be RECEIVED by the closing date, October 11, 2012.

Who May be Considered: U.S. Forest Service (USFS), Bureau of Land Management (BLM), National Park Service (NPS), Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA), U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (FSW), and State and local government department personnel. Great Basin candidates will be considered prior to selecting IC's and/or trainees from other Geographic Areas. Applicants from other Geographic Areas are required to have written concurrence from their Geographic Area Coordinating Group or respective Geographic Area Coordination Center.

*Methods of Evaluation and Selection*: The Great Basin Operations Committee is responsible for reviewing the applications for completeness, and applying ranking criteria to Knowledge, Skills and Abilities (KSA's) to determine the best-qualified candidates. Selections will be made by the Great Basin Coordinating Group. Selections will be made solely on the basis of merit, fitness, and qualifications. All applicants will receive consideration without regard to race, color, age, sex, marital status, religion, national origin, political affiliation, handicap, or other non-merit factors. The Great Basin Coordinating Group Chair is responsible for notification of selection and non-selections.
