Amendment 0002 BAA 08-013 titled "100 kW FEL"

The purpose of Amendment 0003 is to make clarifications regarding the submission of cost proposals.

1. On page 14, under the section entitled, "VOLUME 2: Cost Proposal," the first paragraph is revised as follows (changes in bold):

VOLUME 2: Cost Proposal

The Cost Proposal shall consist of a cover page and two parts, Part 1 will provide a detailed cost breakdown of all costs by cost category by calendar or Government fiscal year and Part 2 will provide a cost breakdown by task/sub-task corresponding to the task numbers in the Statement of Work. A cost proposal is only to be submitted for Task 1, Phase IA. An updated cost estimate should be included for Phases IB, II, and III. If the offeror receives a request from the Navy toward the end of the Task 1 effort, for the work associated with Task 2, then a subsequent formal cost proposal for Task 2 shall be submitted in the same format requested herein.

2. The following question is answered as follows:

Q: The instructions for the full proposal state that "A cost proposal is only to be submitted for Task 1". In other sections of the BAA, it is implied that a cost estimate or cost proposal for the full program (Task 1, Phase IA + Task 2, Phase IB + Task 3, Phase II) is required during the initial white paper and proposal submission. Please confirm whether a cost estimate (for the white paper) and cost proposal (for the full proposal) are required for Tasks 1-3, or only for Task 1.

A: In accordance with BAA 08-013, the content of both the white paper and the full proposal shall address all Phases (Phase IA/B, II and III (Page 11)). The white paper requires a "cost estimate" for all three Phases (Page 12). The full proposal requires a "cost proposal" only for Task 1 (Phase IA - Page 14) and an updated "cost estimate" for Phase IB, II and III. However, at the end of each Task and before the next Task a "cost proposal" shall be submitted to support the government's decision for the succeeding Task Order (Page 8-9).
