Reasons to Suspect a Volunteer/Trainee is Missing

- V/T did not show up to a scheduled meeting with counterpart, Peace Corps staff or other V/Ts (including ISTs, VAC meetings, medical appointments, etc.)
- Suspected foul play (i.e. robbery, kidnapping, assault, etc.)
- V/T did not respond in an appropriate or normally expected amount of time during a test of the Emergency Action Plan.
- V/T in area with known political violence or natural disaster and cannot be contacted.
- Health and welfare inquiry from family or friends in the United States.
- V/T did not return from leave on time.
- Other V/T believes that a V/T may be missing (see training proposal).
