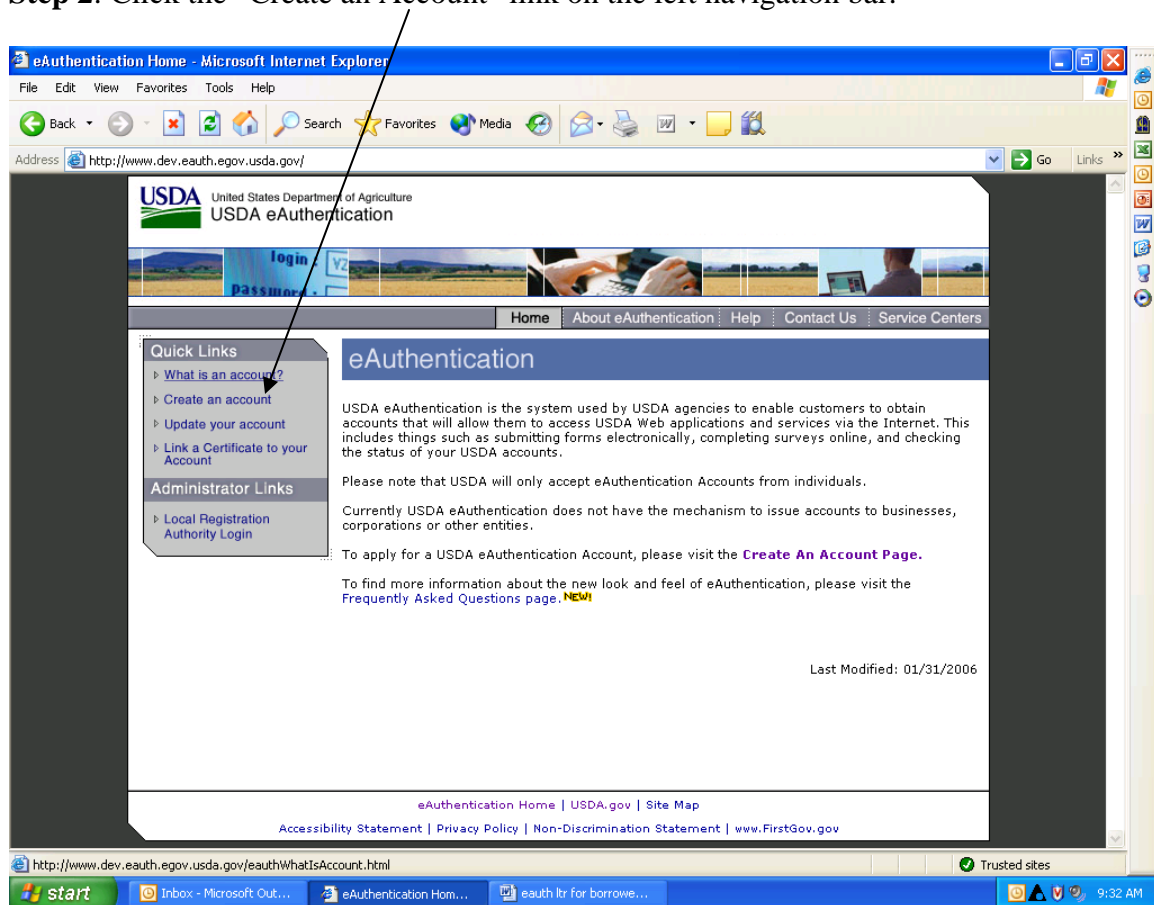
Obtaining Access to the Broadband Collection and Access System

Obtaining a USDA eAuthentication Account

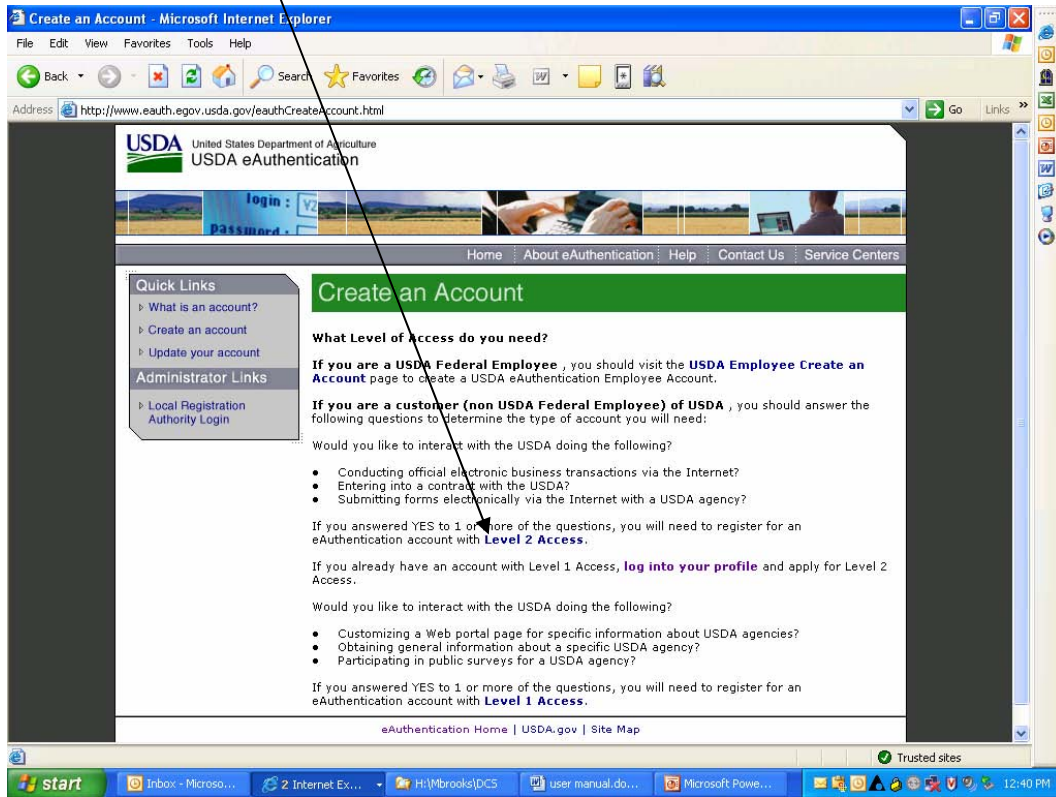
In order to access the Broadband Collection and Analysis System, you will need to have a Level 2 USDA eAuthentication (eAuth) Account. To obtain a Level 2 eAuth Account:

Step 1: Visit the USDA eAuthentication website at: <http://www.eauth.egov.usda.gov/>

Step 2: Click the “Create an Account” link on the left navigation bar.



Step 3: Click on **Level 2 Access** in the middle of the page.



Step 4: Complete all of the required fields and click on the Continue button. It is suggested that you use first name.last name as your User ID. For example: John.Doe.

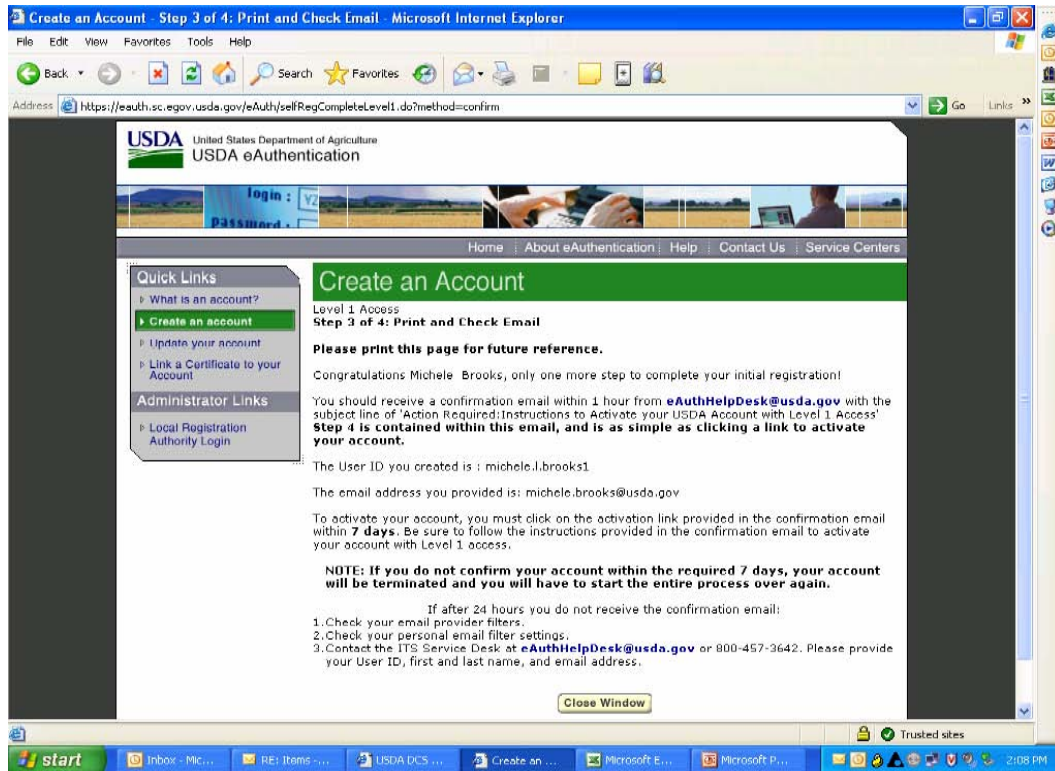

Step 5: Verify that the information is correct and click on the Submit button. Otherwise go back and correct the incorrect data.



Step 6: Print this page for reference.



Step 7: You will receive a confirmation e-mail within one hour. Then wait at least 20 minutes and activate your account by clicking on the link in the e-mail.

At this point you will have a Level 1 eAuthentication account. To get it raised to a Level 2 you will need to be Identity Proofed by a USDA Local Registration Authority (LRA).

Getting Identity Proofed by a USDA LRA

Local Registration Authorities (LRAs) are USDA employees who are trained to act as the “trusted entity” to validate the identity of a customer in eAuthentication. The role of the LRA can be compared to a Notary Public who ensures the identity of an individual conducting official business transactions. All our General Field Representatives (GFR) are LRAs; however, if your assigned GFR is not available you may visit a local USDA office for identity-proofing. The list of local USDA offices is available at: <http://offices.sc.egov.usda.gov/locator/app>.

Once you have registered for a Level 1 eAuthentication account, you will need to have a LRA Identity Proof you using a State or Government-issued identification card. Once this has been done, your eAuthentication account will be raised to a Level 2, which will allow you access to the BCAS.

Obtaining Access to BCAS

In order to obtain access to the BCAS, your Organization must identify you as the Borrower Administrator for the organization. This is done by:

Step 1: The Board of Directors must approve a resolution identifying the Borrower Administrator and Borrower Certifier for the Organization.

Step 2: Completing a Form 674, “Certificate of Authority to Submit or Grant Access to Data” identifying the Borrower Administrator and Borrower Certifier for the Organization, as named in the Board Resolution.

Step 3: Mailing the Form 674 and Board Resolution to

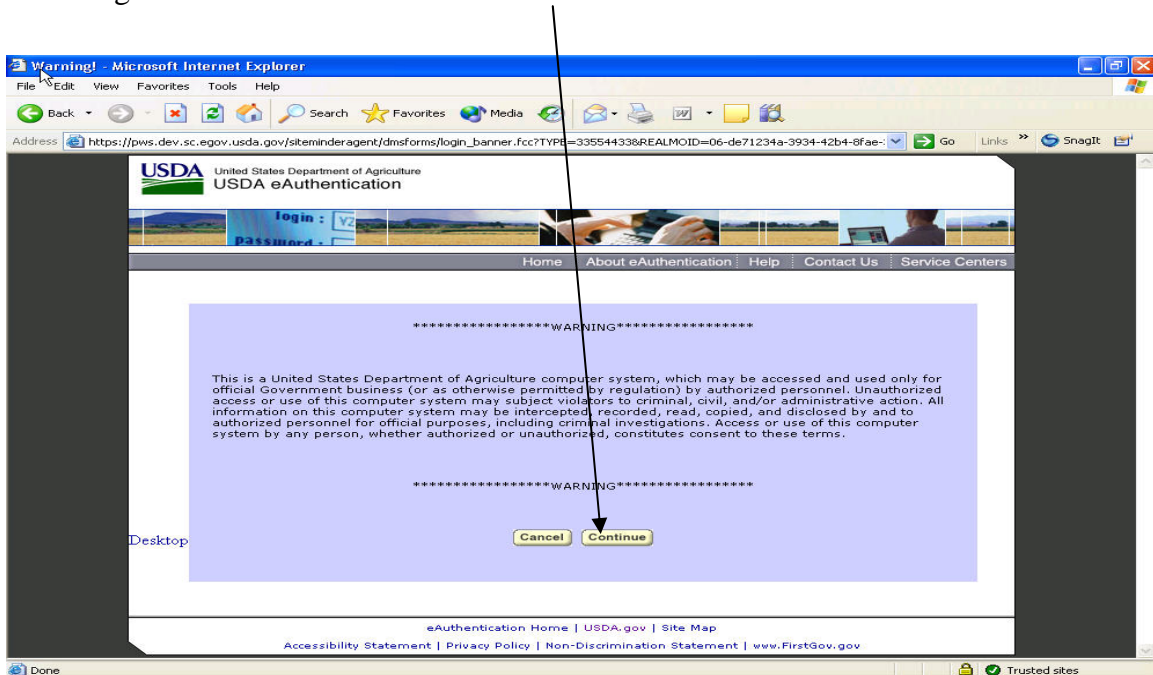

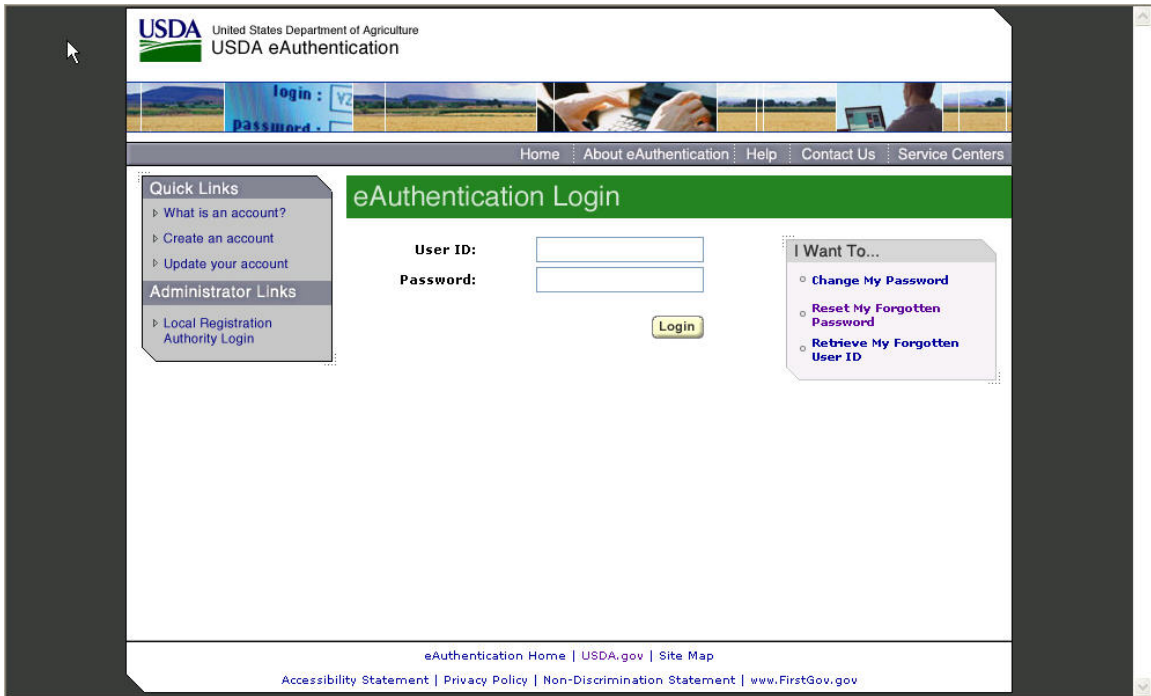
Logging on to BCAS

Note: Borrower Administrators and Borrower Certifiers cannot log on to BCAS until the Form 674 is submitted with the resolution and the Rural Development grants them access. Borrower Users and Borrower Readers cannot log on to BCAS until the Borrower Administrator grants them access.

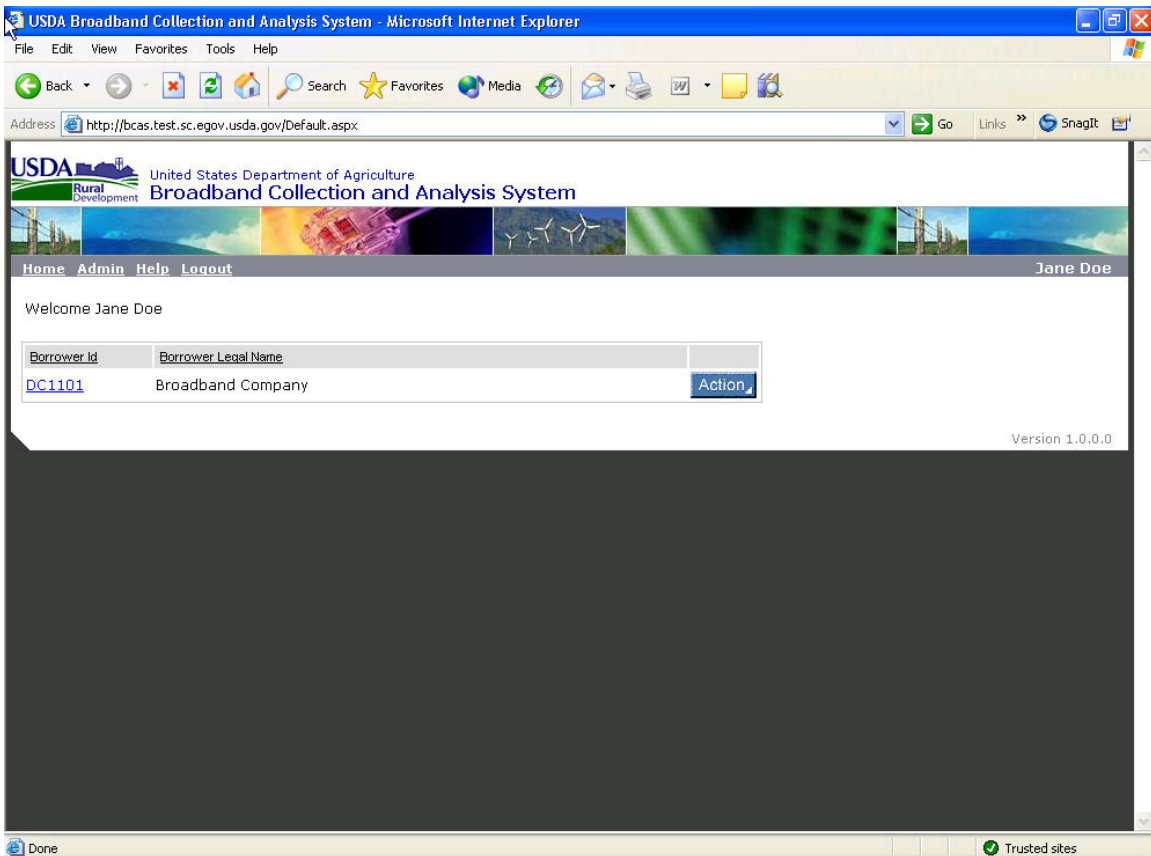
To access the BCAS go to: <https://bcas.sc.egov.usda.gov>. You will come to the following screen and should click the Continue button:

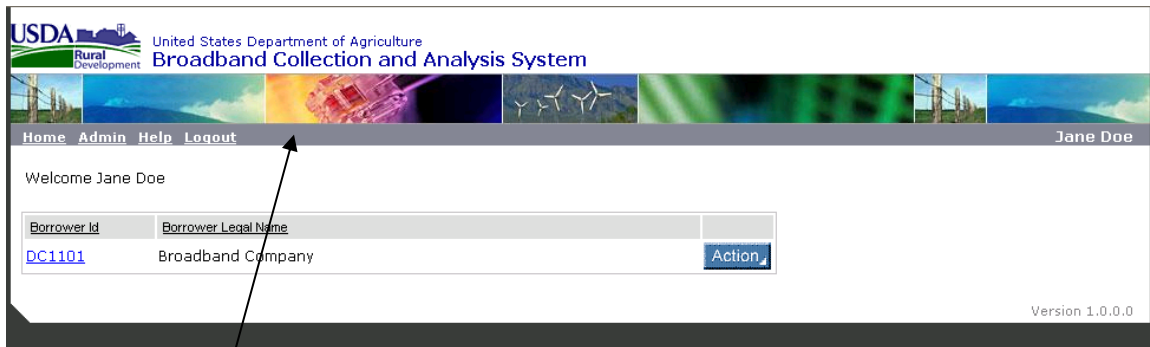


Enter your Level 2 eAuthentication ID in the User ID box and the password in the Password box.



You are now logged into the BCAS and should see the following screen with your company name.





The grey navigation bar contains four options:

Home: Returns the user to the home screen (Seen above).

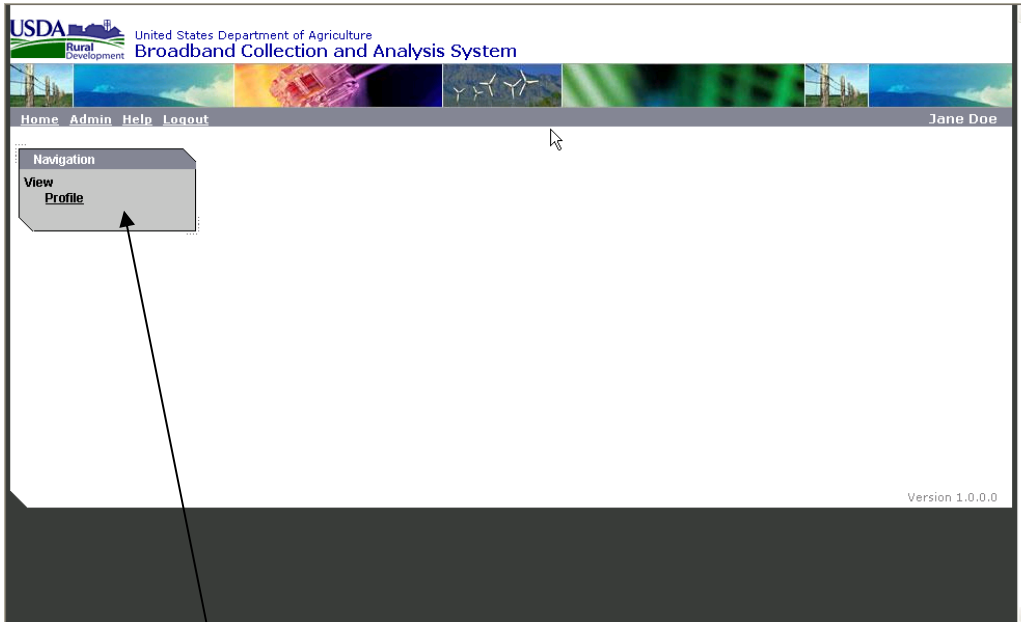
Admin: Directs the user to the administrative portion of the database. Borrower Certifier, Borrower Reader, and Borrower User can only view their own contact information from this page. The Borrower Administrator can add and edit users for their company information.

Help: Contain help on the current screen.

Logout: Logs the user out of the Broadband Collection and Analysis System

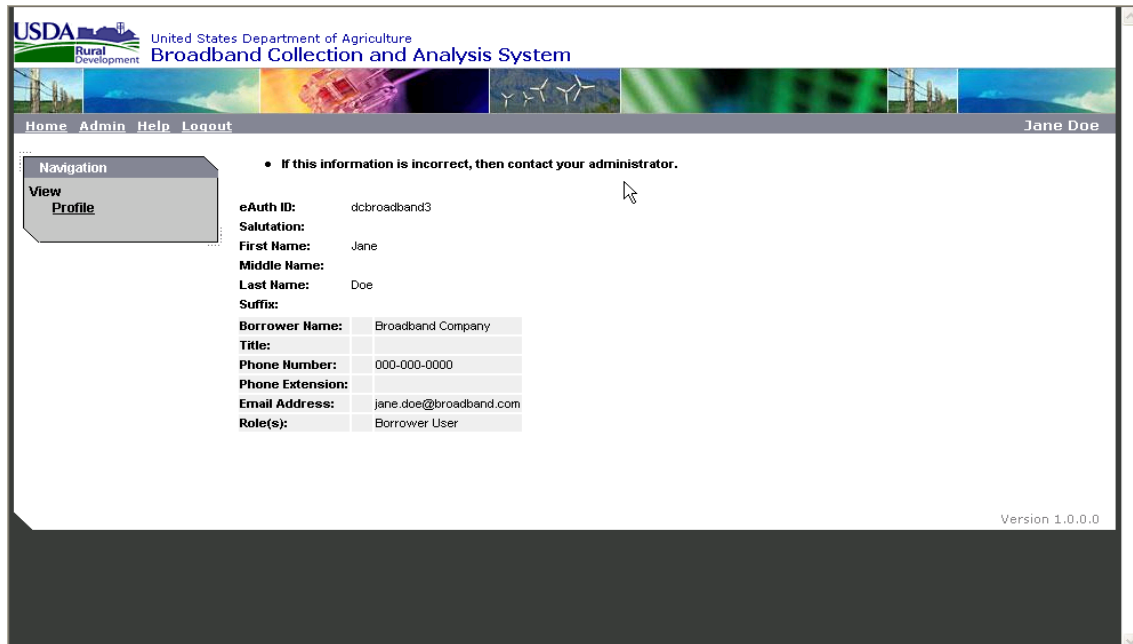
Viewing Profile Information

For Borrower User, Reader, and Certifier, the Admin screen is as follows:



The grey navigation box on the left lists the user's options. Only underlined words in the menu are active. The User, Reader, and Certifier can view their contact information by clicking on Profile.

Borrower Administrator is the only person with authority to change this information. Instructions for adding users or editing their information are contained in Section 2.

Instructions for RDUP Form 674 (03-06)

CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY TO SUBMIT OR GRANT ACCESS TO DATA

This form, along with a board resolution, is submitted to the Rural Utilities Service, an agency delivering the U.S. Department of Agriculture Rural Development Utilities Programs, hereinafter referred to as the Agency, to establish the “Certifier” who will certify and submit data included on the identified Agency data collections and the “Security Administrator” who will give appropriate, access to the Borrower’s data to other employees, officers, or contractors.

Submit the original of the completed form in hard copy and a board resolution to Rural Development Utilities Programs, Attention Deputy Director Program Development and Regulatory Analysis, 1400 Independence Ave., SW, Stop 1522, Washington, DC 20250 with a copy to the assigned General Field Representative or Field Accountant.

All items on the form are to be completed by the Borrower.

1. General

1.1 Borrowers' operating reports furnish the Agency with information that it needs for analyses concerning the security of Government loans, for the preparation of estimates to be used in forecasting expenses for future loans and for the Agency to fulfill its reporting obligations. The Agency believes that these reports, when supplemented by such additional information as each borrower may choose, will also be of great assistance to the boards of directors and managers in successfully coping with a variety of management issues. The operating reports also provide the Agency with the data it needs to prepare the Annual Statistical Report which encompasses all Electric program borrowers' operations.

1.2 The USDA Rural Development Data Collection System (DCS) is an automated system that allows data entry of information that usually was entered on paper forms and/or earlier software systems. The data is stored in a database with all the associated advantages (e.g., data integrity checks, ease of retrieval). The system is designed to use the Internet for data exchange between the Agency and its Borrowers.

2. Access to System by User

2.1 Subject to the terms and conditions of these Instructions, the Agency grants to the Borrower a non-exclusive right to use the DCS, including any updates and enhancements to the DCS, the output of the DCS and the Instructions and other documentation for the DCS that may be provided to the borrower by the Agency. The borrower will cause data to be entered into the DCS only as requested by the Agency personnel with respect to the loan contract for an existing loan or loan guarantee. Borrower's use of the DCS is subject to the provisions of the Instructions and such other instructions as may be communicated by the Agency from time-to-time in writing.

2.2 Borrower's access to the DCS is dependent upon the eAuthentication system that will require the Borrower Certifier and Security Administrator and specific employees or agents of the Borrower to specify a User identification number and password as part of the sign-on procedure. In addition, all Users of the DCS may be required to complete annual security awareness training as required by the system. Borrower will immediately notify Rural Development (i) if Borrower terminates the employment or agency of one of its authorized Users, or (ii) in the event of any loss, theft or unauthorized disclosure or use of any User identification number or password. Individual User identification numbers and passwords may not be transferred between employees and agents, and Borrower shall ensure that such transfers do not occur. If the Agency becomes aware of misuse of identification numbers and passwords, access to the system will be immediately revoked until the incident of misuse can be resolved. Borrower recognizes that it is responsible for controlling access to the DCS. The Borrower will

permit the Agency, from time-to time upon reasonable notice to the Borrower, to audit or review Borrower's controls and procedures related to access to the DCS.

2.3 Borrower represents and warrants that all information that it has submitted to the Agency in the course of registering as a User, and upon which the Agency has relied in agreeing to permit User to access and use DCS, is true and correct.

3. Warranties; Limitation of Liability

3.1 No Warranty.

It is the Agency's desire to operate a System, which satisfies the performance objectives established by the Agency. However, the Agency makes no representation or warranty with respect to DCS. In addition, the Agency makes no representation or warranty with respect to any of the data obtained, provided or transmitted by or through the System. EXCEPT TO THE EXTENT EXPRESSLY PROVIDED OTHERWISE IN THESE INSTRUCTIONS, THE SYSTEM IS BEING PROVIDED TO USER "AS IS" AND ALL WARRANTIES ARE EXPRESSLY EXCLUDED.

3.2 No Liability.

The Agency will have no liability under these Instructions or related in any respect to the System (including, without limitation, under any other agreement with Borrower related to the System) for consequential, exemplary, indirect or incidental damages, even if it has been advised of the possibility of such damages.

4. Data

Subject to Federal laws and regulations regarding confidential information, the Agency may use, retain, and reproduce (a) all data for auditing and other purposes that pertain to loans that the Agency may make or guarantee, (b) all data generated utilizing the DCS that pertains to the functionality or performance of the DCS, (c) all data necessary or useful in assisting the Agency in the diagnosis or correction of any irregularity, error, problem, or defect in the DCS, the measurement of software or service usage, the protection or security of the DCS or password protected areas of the Agency's Internet sites, the performance of system or network maintenance, or evaluation of its software or services, or any improvement, upgrades or enhancements thereto, (d) all data necessary or useful in performing its obligations under this Agreement, providing reports to the Borrower or responding to Borrower requests, and (e) all data that the Borrower is required to report or make available to Rural Development pursuant to any other agreement(s) between the Borrower and Rural Development.

5. Amendments to Usage

The Agency may amend the terms of these Instructions at any time through notice to the Borrower setting forth the terms of such amendment. Borrower's use of DCS at any time after the effective date of an amendment shall constitute Borrower's consent to the terms of the amendment.

6. Revision of RDUP Form 674

Any proposed revision to the resolutions attached to RDUP Form 674 must be made in writing and will be deemed delivered and accepted by the Agency when acknowledgment by the Agency is received by the Borrower.

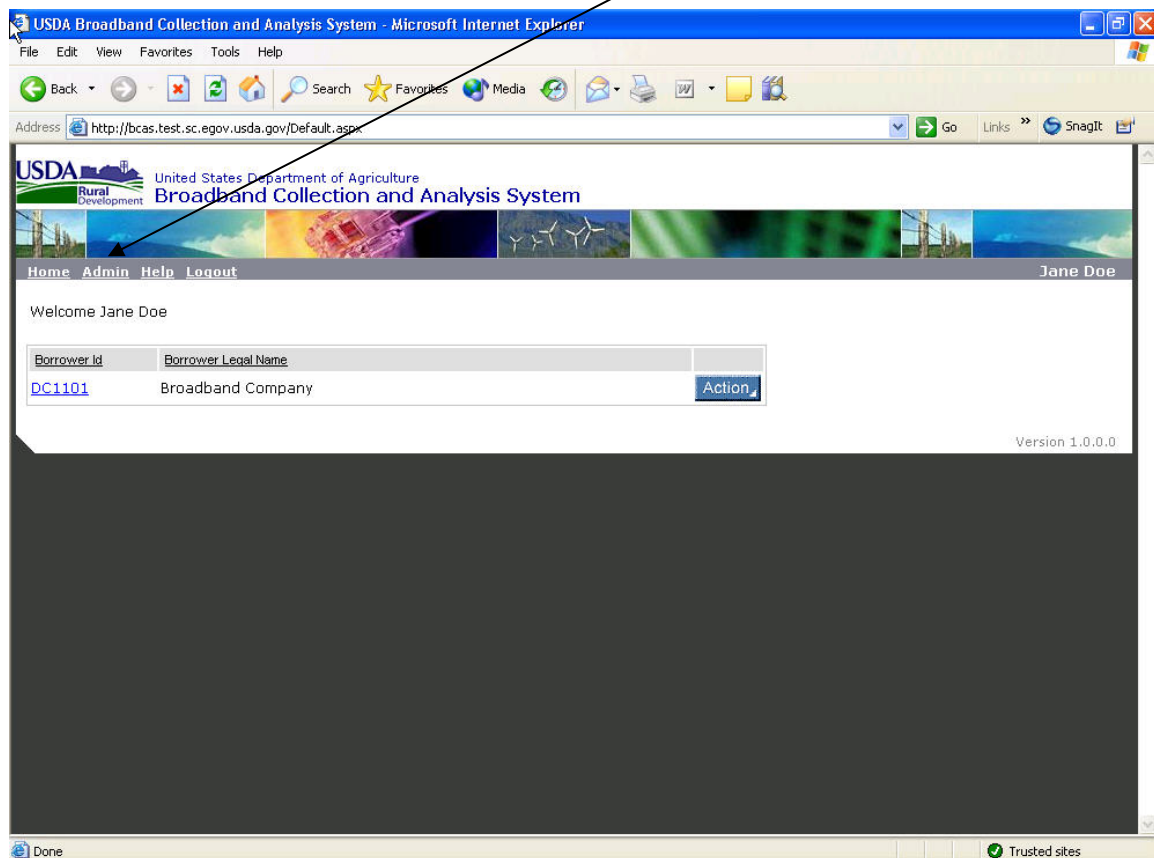
Section 2

Roles and Responsibilities of the Borrower Administrator

The Borrower Administrator will be responsible for:

- Giving access to other employees to allow them to be readers or users of the BCAS system;
- Removing access rights to the system for readers and users that should no longer have access to the system;
- Editing employee contact information;
- Determining employees to receives system notifications.

To access that portion of the database, click on Admin in the grey navigation bar:



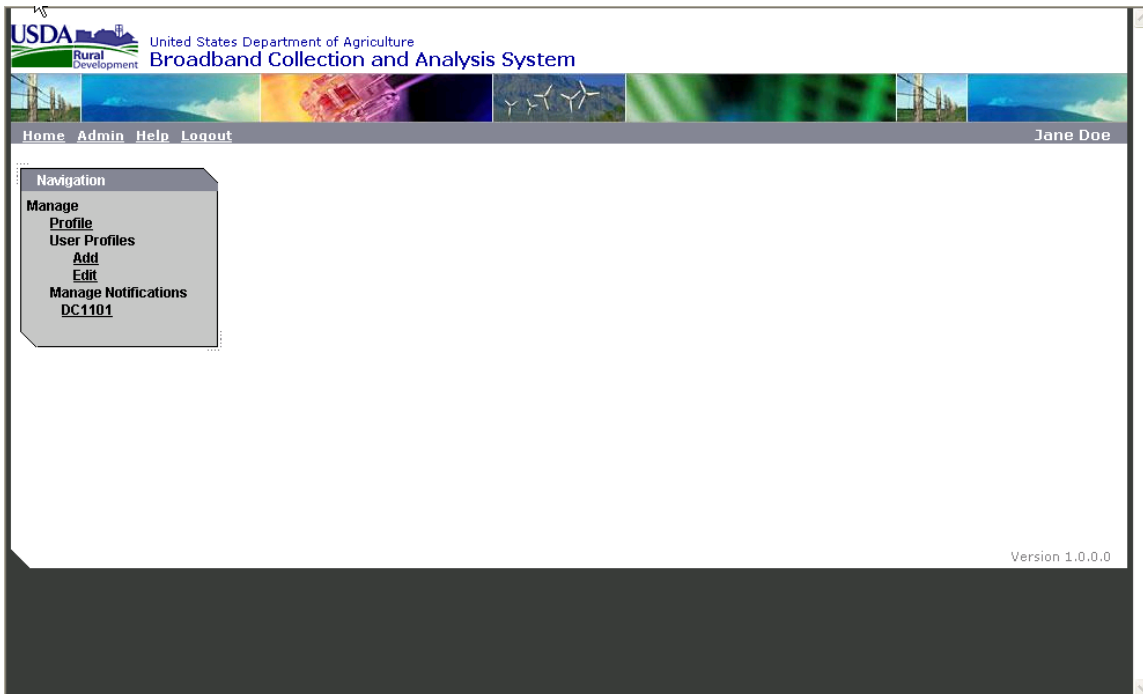
The grey box on the left list the options available to the Borrower Administrator:

Profile: View your contact information. This can only be revised by the System Administrator (Rural Development)

User Profile – Add: Add users as Readers or Users of your company’s data

User Profile – Edit: Edit contact information or deactivate Readers or Users

Manage Notifications: Determine which users receive system notifications.

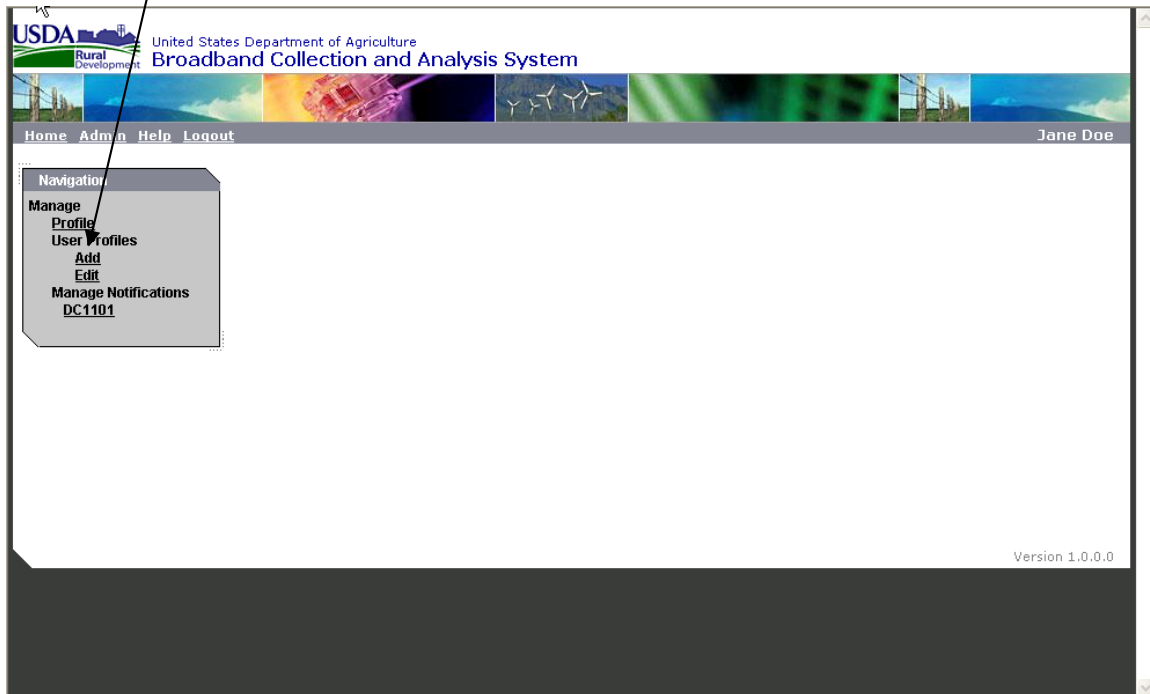


Adding Borrower Users and Readers to BCAS

The user or reader who wants to be added to the system must have obtained an eAuthentication Account before you can add them. They must have been Identity Proofed as well before they can use the system.

To add users and readers to the system click on the Admin link on the grey navigation bar.

Click the Add link under “Manage User Profiles” on the left navigation menu.



You must first select the company to which the user will be added. Click on the drop down box to select your company by either the Borrower Name or its Rural Development Borrower Designation (for example: DC 1101). You will only see companies for which you submitted a Form 674.

In the eAuthId box, type in the new user's eAuthentication ID, then click on the Add button. The system will check to see that the eAuthentication account exists.

Deactivating a User or a Reader

To remove users and readers from the system click on the Admin link on the top grey navigation bar. Then select Edit under “Manage User Profiles” on the left navigation menu.

Select the user and the Edit Borrower screen will appear. To remove the person’s access to the system, uncheck the Active box, then click on the Save button. The person will no longer be able to access the system. You can also edit contact information from this page.

Manage Notifications

The Broadband Collection and Analysis System send notification e-mails to remind borrowers to submit their quarterly reports and sends regular notifications if the reports are not submitted as required by the loan documents.

1. The Submission Reminder is an automated e-mail reminder to the borrowers to file their operating report on the last day of the reporting period. For example for the March report, an e-mail is sent on March 31.
2. The Late Reminder is an automated e-mail reminder to the borrowers for a past due operating report 15 days after the end of each reporting period. An additional e-mail reminder will be sent to the borrower every seven days until the borrower submits the late operating report.

The Borrower Administrator will manage who receives the Submission Reminder and the Late Reminder e-mail notifications.

1. The default is for all users assigned to the borrower to receive the Submission Reminder and the Late Reminder e-mail notifications.
2. The Borrower Admin may choose to select or deselect a user from receiving these e-mails, however at least one borrower user must be assigned to the Submission Reminder and/or the Late Reminder e-mail notifications.

Select or unselect the contacts to receive the notification e-mails, and click the 'Save' button when finished.

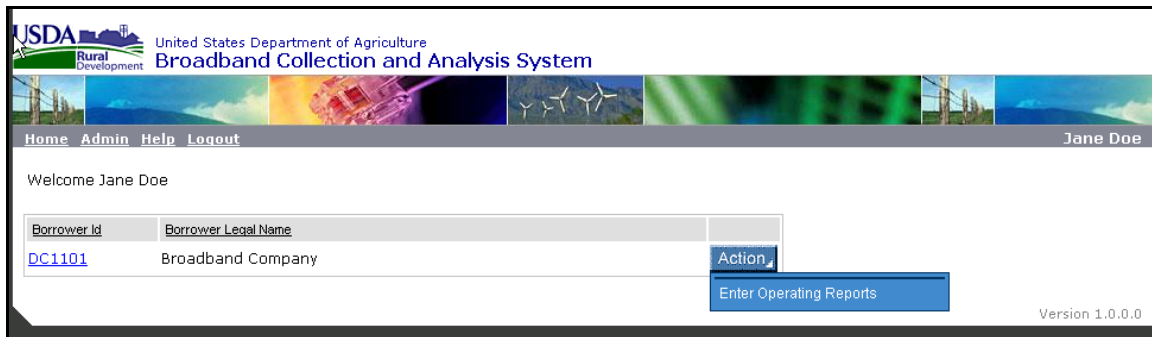
Inputting and Submitting Data

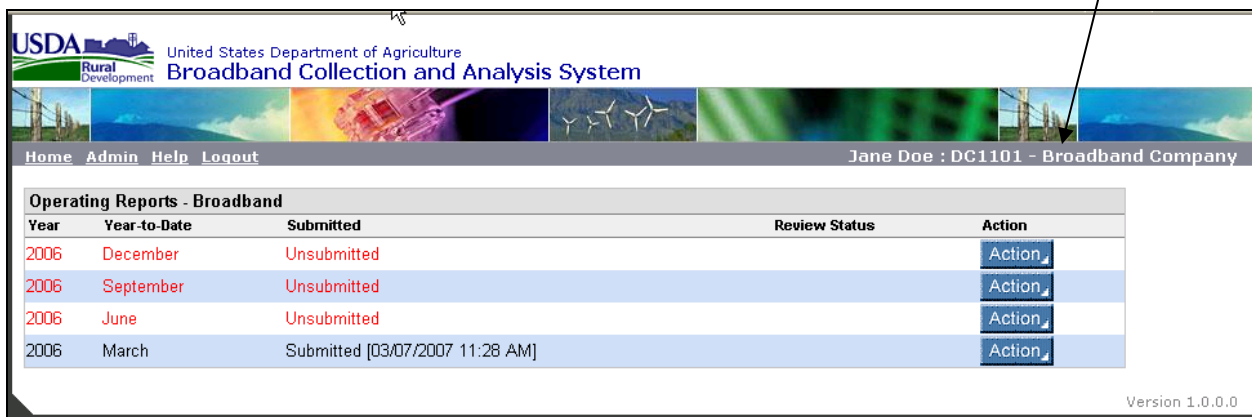
Getting Started - Creating a Blank Report

Beginning at the Welcome Screen, each company to which the user has access has an Action button.

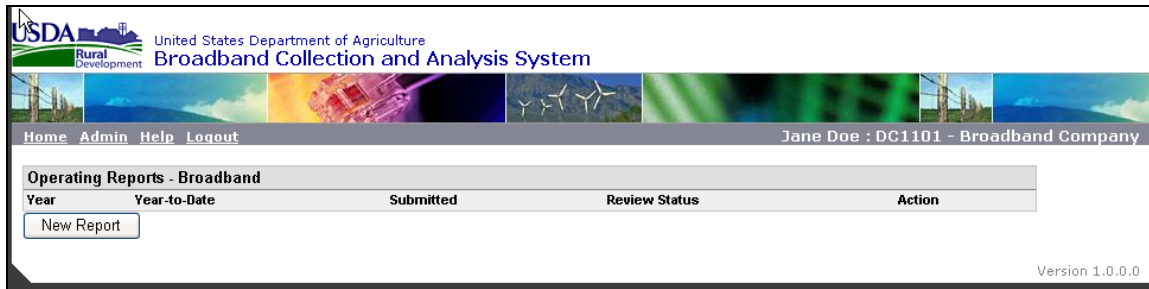
1. Click on the “Action” button, and then select “Enter Operating Reports”.



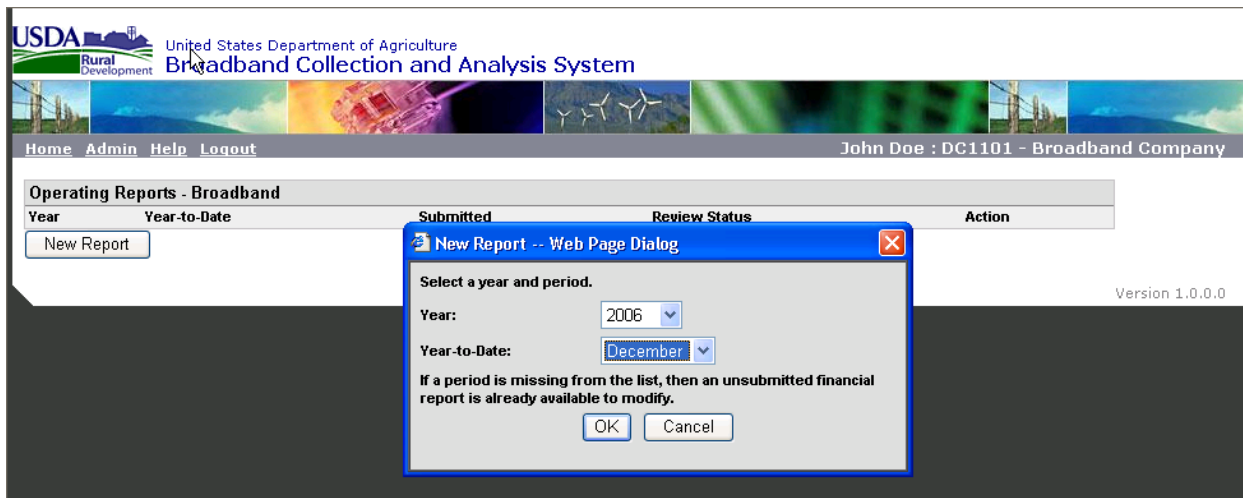
2. The next screen will show all Submitted (in black) and Unsubmitted (in red) reports for the particular borrower. Also to the right, the company name is listed on the gray navigation bar.



3. The first time the database is accessed there should be no reports shown. Click on the New Report button.

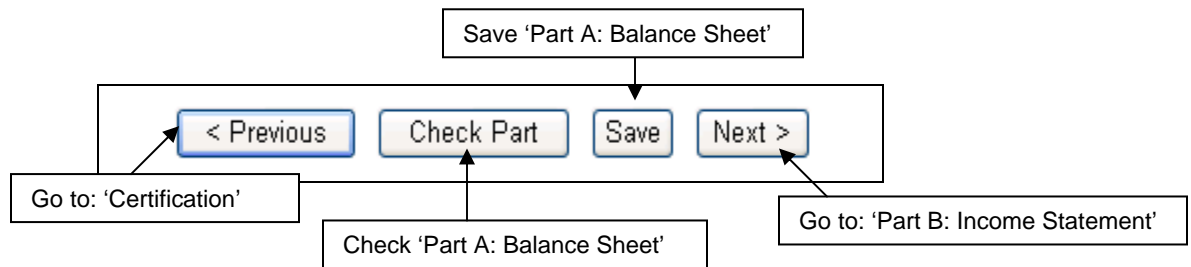

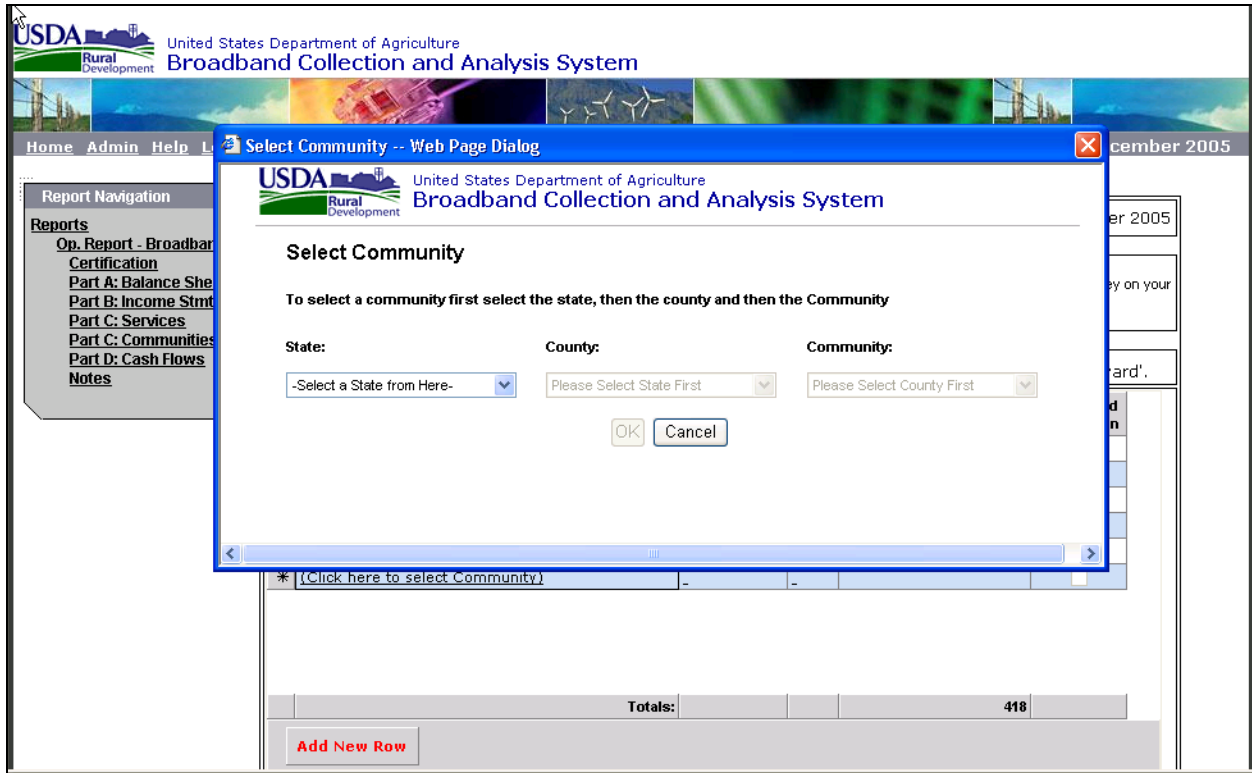

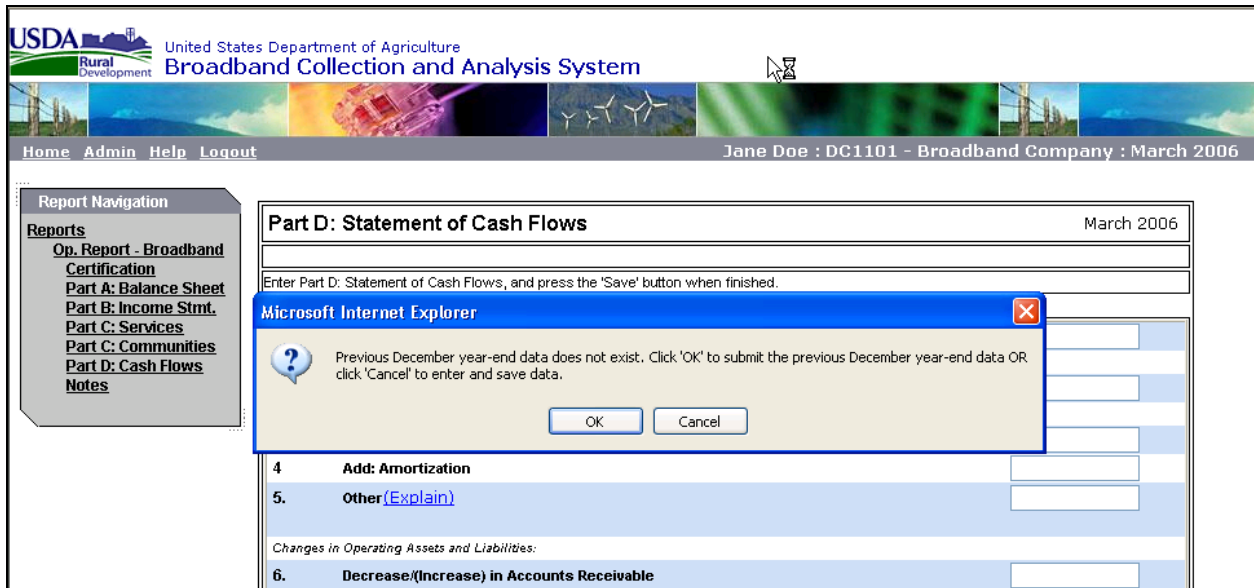

If the user was required to submit a previous yearend report and had not done so, the user will be prompted by the pop-up box shown below to submit that report prior to completing the current period Statement of Cash Flows. The user can also go back to input the previous yearend report by clicking “OK” in the pop-up box. 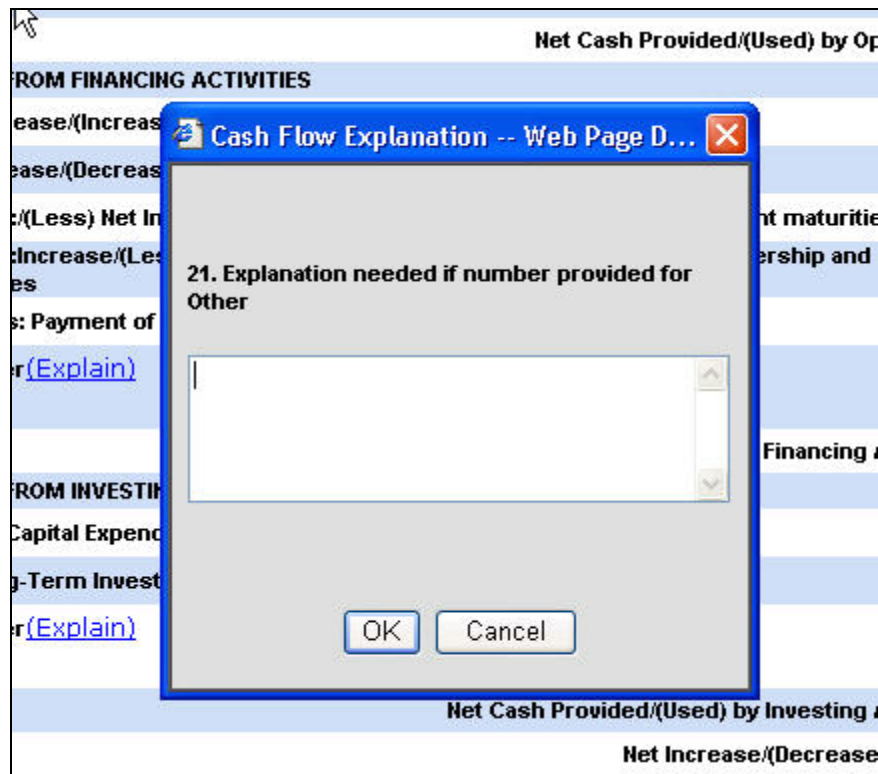
In all cases the user must supply the data for line items 19 (Net Capital Expenditures) and 20 (Long Term Investments). These items cannot be properly calculated from the input on the balance sheet.

Net Capital Expenditures will reflect new plant investment (input as a negative number to represent the outflow of cash) plus cash proceeds received from plant sales and retirements.

Long Term Investments will reflect the cash effects of the purchase and sale of long term investments that are not already captured in Net Income.

Additionally, there may be instances where the line items shown in the cash flow statement do not reflect all cash transactions. The statement provides “Other” lines under Cash Flows from Operation Activities (line 5), Cash Flows from Financing Activities (line 17), and Cash Flows from Investing Activities (line 21) for such transactions.

When data is input in these line items, an explanation of the transaction is required. Click on the blue “Explain” text to input the required explanation.
