

# Don't let your LincPass certificate expire!

Check using one of two methods:

Subtract two years from the date in front of your card and you can **estimate** when the certificate on your card will expire.



The LincPass certificate expiration date is different from the LincPass' physical expiration date on the card and is usually not the same date. We can estimate this card will expire October 10, 2011

This is an **approximation** but does not require a card reader.

Insert your card in an available card reader.



## Open MS Explorer

1. Click on **Tools**
2. Click on **Internet Options**
3. Click on **Content** Tab
4. Click on **Certificates** box
5. Check **Expiration Date**

This is the most accurate method, but requires a card reader.

You should receive a 90, 60, 30 day email reminder.
