- Reference email to Regional FMOs re: FS letter (Tidwell) interim strategy for 401 job series generated by OPM review of FS (creditable education)
 - o 301 series pathway not approved by FS or USDA yet
 - 462 series below mgmt level (7/8/9)
 - o BIA and other DOI Bureaus sticking to 401 series
 - Long-term impact of FS decision to be determined

- DOI not part of any FS discussions especially with regard to new fire job series
- Proposed NWCG memo (see email) re: implementation of NIMS training requirement in IQCS (IS700) will affect all Bureaus
 - o 118 pg printout of BIA employees not in compliance
 - o September 2011 implementation date impacts?
 - I300/I400 may be ok due to recognition of prior/current positions (recognition rule does not apply to IS700/IS800)
 - Even given recognition, BIA may not be ready
 - Systematic problems with DOI Learn
 - o !!! Check list and respond to Koch by 8/12 with list of impacts to your region
