NIFC Updates

Deputy Fire Director, Bodie Shaw

- All BIA-NIFC Staff is migrating their email server to be @bia.gov. The migration will be complete by July 30. Please update emailing lists appropriately.

Budget Officer, Maggie Morran

- Budget Handbook is almost complete. Budget shop appreciates the regions that provided data to create the SOP. Once complete, Bodie/Lyle will send to regions for review and comment.
 - Budget shop is working on Preparedness and awards information to pay to IDC
- Maggie sent an email to regions notifying them their CRs were reviewed and funded. If you did not receive an email, the CR was not funded.
 - CRs were not considered because:
