Colonel Christopher Roscoe Commander, 405th Army Field Support Brigade

Colonel Christopher Roscoe assumed command of the 405th Army Field Support Brigade Jul 2012.

Col. Roscoe possesses a Master's in Business Administration (concentration: Finance and Accounting) from the University of Illinois at Chicago, 1997. Col. Chris Roscoe earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Microbiology from Texas A&M University in 1986. He then attended Basic Training at Fort Leonard Wood, Mo., and Officer Candidate School at Fort Benning, Ga., both in 1987. He was commissioned a Second Lieutenant, Armor Branch, with a branch detail to Ordnance in 1991. He is a graduate of the Armor Basic Course, Ordnance Advanced Course, Command and General Staff College, and is currently an Army War College Fellow at the George C. Marshall Center in Garmisch, Germany.



His initial assignment was to B Company, 3rd Battalion, 66th Armor Regiment in Garlstedt, Germany, serving as platoon leader and assistant battalion S-3; then, Executive Officer of D Company, 2nd Battalion, 66th Armor and XO of the 2nd Armored Division (FWD) Canadian Army Trophy Team, until deployed to Operation Desert Storm. He subsequently joined the 43rd Area Support Group at Fort Carson, Colorado. Additional shaping assignments: Company Commander of 73rd General Support Heavy Maintenance Company, 68th Corps Support Battalion, Fort Carson; XO to the Deputy Chief of Staff for Resource Management, TRADOC, Fort Monroe, Va.; 21st Theater Support Command SPO Emergency Operations Center Officer in Charge, Kaiserslautern; Battalion XO for 127th Aviation Support Bn., 1st AD, Hanau; Deputy G4, then Chief, Division Material Maintenance Center, 1st AD, Wiesbaden; XO to the Intelligence Director, J2, NATO, Naples, Italy; Battalion Commander of the 18th Combat Sustainment Support Battalion, Grafenwoehr; and Distribution Management Center Chief for the 21st Theater Sustainment Command, Kaiserslautern.

Deployments include Operations Desert Shield/Desert Storm in 1991 as Tank Company XO, Somalia in 1993 as a Brigade Maintenance Officer, OIF 1 (Baghdad) in 2003-2004 as 1st AD DMMC Chief and OIF 08-10 (Mosul) in 2008-2009 as Battalion Commander.

His awards include the Legion of Merit, the Bronze Star with two Oak Leaf Clusters, the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, the Army Meritorious Service Medal with two oak leaf clusters and the Combat Action Badge. He has also been awarded the Samuel Sharpe Medal.
