Pamela Green Perkins is the Administrative Manager for the Board of Elections in the City of New York. Appointed in December 2002, Mrs. Perkins oversees all operations of the Board of Elections, including management analysis and planning. In addition she is responsible for the day to day operations at the Executive office, and the 5 Borough offices and their Voting Machine Facilities throughout the City Of New York. As Administrative Manager she served as a member of the Executive Steering Committee for the transition to new voting systems in New York City.

In 1996, New York City's Commissioners of Elections appointed her to the executive level position of Agency Chief Contracting Officer. Mrs. Perkins was the first person of color to hold such a senior level position at the Board. As the Agency Chief Contracting Officer she was responsible for all the contracting of goods and services for the New York City Board of Elections.

Pamela Perkins employment at the Board of Election in the City of New started in 1994 she served as Deputy Chief Clerk at the City Board of Elections' Manhattan Borough Office where she supervised the work of all Board employees at both the borough office and the voting machine facility as they served the voters of that borough.

Before joining the Board of Elections, Ms. Perkins served with the New York State Division of Human Rights, Crisis Prevention Unit. During her tenure at the Human Rights Division, she responded to bias-related incidents throughout the City and State of New York.

Pamela Green-Perkins serves as an inspiring role model for hundreds of young women throughout her community. She is a graduate of Southampton College of Long Island University with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Criminal Justice.
