Colonel Ronald E. Paul is Commander, 183rd Fighter Wing, Illinois Air National Guard, Abraham Lincoln Capital Airport, Springfield, IL. The wing provides support to the Air Force and Air National Guard with an Air Operations Group, Centralized Engine Repair Facility, Medical Group, Mission Support Group, and an Engineering and Installation Squadron. The wing's unique missions support wartime contingencies for 12th Air Force, USAF, and the ANG.
