The United States Agency for International Development (USAID) Timor-Leste Mission is seeking applications from local Timorese NGOs to implement a program to improve the Timor-Leste National Police's (PNTL) responsiveness to its citizens, and to enhance overall public safety and security. This program will contribute to the development of the rule of law and the security sectors by: (1) monitoring threats to public safety; (2) improving police-community relations and (3) strengthening the ability of the PNTL to respond to the needs and concerns of the Timorese public.
