Dear Chairman Johnson, Minority Leader Richard Shelby and Committee Members:

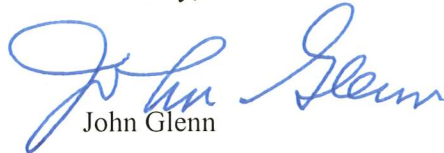
I write to voice my strong support for Richard Cordray to lead the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau.
