

SUBJECT: Authority for Use of Other Transactions for Prototype Projects

The John Warner National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2007 requires written determination for authority to use other transactions for prototype projects estimated to exceed \$20,000,000. This applies to prototype projects that are directly related to weapons or weapon systems that are proposed to be developed or acquired by the Department of Defense. The act also requires us to notify the congressional defense committees at least 30 days prior to experiencing the authority for an-other-transaction agreement for a prototype project that is expected to exceed \$100,000,000. The written determination approval levels for the use of other transactions for prototype projects, which may not be delegated, are:
