SUBJECT: Contractor Past Performance Assessment Reporting – 1st Quarter 2012

The Acting USD(AT&L) memorandum dated November 18, 2011, "Past Performance Assessment Reporting," tasked the Director of Defense Procurement and Acquisition Policy to monitor and communicate compliance information to the senior procurement executives on a quarterly basis.

The review of the compliance metrics in PPIRS as of October 3, 2011, identified the overall average for 2008-2010 in the Department as 56%. A review of the metrics as of January 3, 2012, indicates an overall increase of 3% to 59% compliance.

The attached spreadsheet identifies specific agencies with their overall scores. Assessments completed in the first quarter of FY12 for eligible contracts are included. I anticipate there will be a significantly higher number of assessments in the second quarter of FY12 since the period of performance for many contracts ended at the close of FY11 and assessments are due within 120 days. Attention should be paid to reducing the number of overdue reports identified in the attached spreadsheet.
