U.S. Air Force Fact Sheet GLOBAL STRIKE CHALLENGE

Global Strike Challenge is the world's premier bomber, intercontinental ballistic missile (ICBM) and security forces competition with units participating from Air Force Global Strike Command, Air Combat Command, Air Force Material Command, Air Force Reserve Command and the Air National Guard.

Goals

- Showcase the world's premier bomber and ICBM force
- Foster esprit de corps through competition and teamwork
- Recognize outstanding global strike personnel and teams
- Improve combat capabilities through competition and community crosstalk



People and Organization

Approximately 400 competitors take part in Global Strike Challenge events at various locations around the United States. Competition categories include bomber, ICBM and helicopter operations, bomber and ICBM maintenance and security forces. Global Strike Challenge provides the opportunity for teams to improve their knowledge, readiness, effectiveness and esprit de corps through intensive preparation and spirited competition.
